On Thursday women's golf play on October 13 at Rogue Valley Country club will be the second round of the two-ball foursome matches.

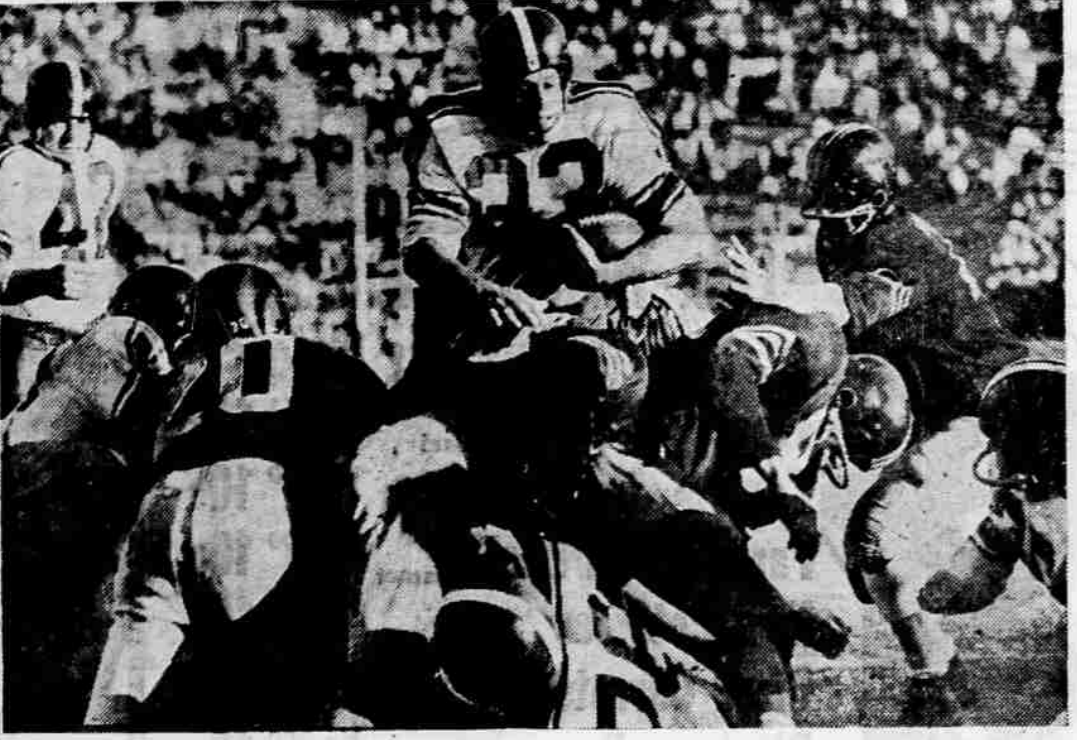
