Dynamite Death At Dillard Probed

Roseburg — (U.P.) — Douglas county authorities today investigated the death of a man following a dynamite explosion in a boxcar in the Dillard area south of here last night.

The body was discovered at about 7 a.m. today when the boxcar, which had been parked on a siding at a lumber mill, was moved to another mill.

Sheriff Ira Byrd identified the man as Robert Ross, about 30. Officers found a 1953 steelworkers union card on the body which listed the address as Fallon, Nev.

County Coroner L. L. (Jim) Powers ordered remains sent to the University of Oregon Medical school in Portland for an autopsy.

The body, found in a corner of the boxcar, was wrapped in three blankets and canvas and the victim wore two pair of trousers. Officers said there had been a dynamite explosion in the car. The boxcar in which the man was found was sidetracked for further study by investigating officers.

Dupree-Poe Loses Freedom Attempt

Salem — (U.P.) — Dupree Poe, one of the ringleaders in several disturbances at Oregon State penitentiary, lost out in his effort to gain freedom from a life sentence through habeas corpus proceedings today.

The Oregon Supreme Court upheld Marion County Circuit Judge George R. Duncan in dismissing Poe's petition for the writ.

Poe was convicted in Marion county in 1932 of murdering a Silverton police officer and was sentenced to life imprisonment. Poe contended the judgment entered in 1932 was void because the late Circuit Judge Fred W. Wilson of The Dalles presided at the trial and claimed it did not appear that Judge L. H. McMahan of Salem was disqualified.

Justice James T. Brand, who wrote the high court opinion, held that the presumption is in favor of the regularity of the assignment of a judge from another district and also noted that Judge Wilson was regularly assigned by the chief justice to hear the case.

Pacific Power-Light, Wyoming Firm Merge

Portland — (U.P.) — Stockholders yesterday voted almost unanimously in favor of merger of Western Public Service Co. with Pacific Power & Light Co., according to Paul B. McKee, Pacific president.

Western serves 5300 customers in Laramie, Wyo. Merger will be accomplished by a stock exchange with PP & L as the surviving company. Pacific's Wyoming division serves 27,000 consumers in the state.

A \$20,000,000 expansion program is planned in Wyoming over the next three years.
