Speculation Continues In Princess-Townsend Romance in Britain

London — (U.P.) — Duty called Princess Margaret again today. And for the second day, Group Capt. Peter Townsend went horseback riding at Epsom. They had not seen each other since Tuesday night.

But there was enough under-surface activity to keep romantic Britons speculating about the progress of their courtship.

Attorney General Called

Prime Minister Anthony Eden called his attorney general from a courtroom appearance, apparently to give urgent advice to the Cabinet. It immediately was speculated that the advice might have to do with legal steps necessary if Margaret does decide she will override opposition from church and family and marry Townsend.

The Rev. C. O. Rhodes, editor of the Church of England newspaper, wrote in a dispatch for the United Press that the church itself is divided on whether a divorced person, such as Townsend, might remarry.

Clergy Divided
He said a recent opinion poll showed that nearly half the clergy disapprove of the convocation which says "the church should not allow the use of the marriage service in the case of anyone who has a partner still living."

Two Persons Hurt In One-Car Crash At Bybee Corner

Two persons were hurt, neither seriously, in a one-car accident at Bybee corner on the Jacksonville highway yesterday at about 3:05 p.m., state police reported.

Geoffrey David Hein, 17, of 704 Hamilton st., was driver of the car, police said. He told officers he was westbound at about 50 miles per hour and that the right front tire blew out just as he rounded the curve. He lost control of the car, which went into Jackson creek, landing right side up.

Two Hospitalized
Taken to the Sacred Heart hospital by Medford Ambulance service were two passengers, Wayman Ross Blackwood, 16, of 440 Highland dr., and Mrs. Johnny Andrew Hood, 23, Riverside apartments. Linda Joyce Hood, 15, another passenger, was not hospitalized. Both of those injured were in good condition today.

There were no injuries resulting from another accident which involved three vehicles, police said. They were a pickup driven by Robert Stanley Chase, 29, route 2, box 80, Central Point; a log truck driven by Floyd Donald Doland Jr., 26, of 375 South Central ave., and a car driven by John Arleigh Heath, 54, box 852, Central Point, officers reported.

Attempts To Pass
The accident report said Heath attempted to pass the truck just as the pickup approached from the other direction, and the car sideswiped both other vehicles. Damage was minor. The accident occurred at about 9:25 p.m. Tuesday on Table Rock rd. near Hammrick rd.

Heath was cited by the investigating officer for passing with insufficient clearance, and Chase was cited for not having an operator's license in his possession, officers said.

Lewd Literature Target at Portland

Portland — (U.P.) — Police Chief Jim Purcell Jr., today promised a crackdown on distribution here of lewd writings and photographs.

Purcell and vice squad officers last night confiscated a large amount of such material from a Second avenue bookstore. The police chief said it was only one of a number of stores which would be searched in the next few days. He said he had received information several months ago that pornographic material was circulating in city schools and added "the condition may still exist."

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Driver of Runaway Truck-Trailer Faces Manslaughter Charge

Cumberland, Md. — (U.P.) — Authorities said today the driver of a runaway truck which smashed into a dump truck and an automobile, killing five persons, near here Wednesday will be charged with manslaughter.

Paul S. Myers, 25, Dover, Pa., who was the only survivor of the grisly accident in heavily populated suburb of La Vale was scheduled to be taken before a trial magistrate today to be booked on a charge of manslaughter with a motor vehicle.

Police said they were investigating reports that a damaged

airline repaired with friction tape caused the brakes on Myers' tractor-trailer, loaded with sheet aluminum to fail as he descended Bib Savage mountain on U.S. Route 40 near Frostburg, five miles west of here.

Ashland Curfew Bill Gives Earlier Deadline

Ashland — A curfew amendment, passed Tuesday night by Ashland city council, set 10:30 p.m., rather than midnight as the time youngsters under 18 must be off the streets.

The amendment, intended primarily to keep children from loitering on the streets and in public places, provides exemptions for those going to or from work or police-approved functions.

Driver Decapitated
The driver of the dump truck, Samuel A. Brennenman, 29, of Springs, Pa., was decapitated in the collision, apparently by a sheet aluminum from the truck load. The other four victims died in their flaming car. Myers walked away from the tangled wreckage of the three vehicles with only minor injuries.

The occupants of the car, all badly burned, were identified as Clifford P. Fearer, 38, assistant manager of Cumberland Steel Co.; Nellie Thomas, 31, payroll clerk and cashier at the Buchanan Lumber Co.; and Francis X. Spearman, 59, and Grace E. Lloyd, 35, clerical employees of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad. All four were Frostburg resi-
