Gold Hill - C. Norman Gail has been named to a three-year term on the board of directors of the Gold Hill Irrigation district, it was announced today by district officials.

Gail, the only candidate for whom a petition was filed, was named by the board of directors. No election is necessary, according to state law, when petitions are filed for only one candidate. Gail will be serving his first full term on the board of directors. He was named about a year ago to fill the unexpired term of A. J. Michaels, who resigned to move to Ellensburg, Wash.

Other members of the board are G. Ivan Peoples, president, and Lester Parker.

Crippled Cargo Ship Nears Port

Anchorage, Alaska - (U.P.) - The crippled cargo vessel, Flying Eagle, with a heavy tug in escort, was expected to put into port at Adak, Alaska, today after a battle with a North Pacific storm.

The Navy said neither the ship nor its 45 crewmen were in any danger and the vessel was proceeding toward Adak at eight knots an hour along with the tug, Towasa.

Meanwhile, the Greek freighter Macedonia damaged a propeller about 300 miles south of Attu island in the Aleutian chain and Navy ship, the USS Molalla was standing by pending arrival of a tug from Vancouver, B.C.

Tips Checked in Hunt For Missing Youngster

East Meadow, N.Y. - (U.P.) - Detectives today checked telephoned tips in their search for three-year-old Stephen Damman, missing since Monday.

Persons with records of sex offenses against children were questioned on the chance that the boy may have been kidnaped. Police also checked records for recent child deaths on the theory that Stephen might have been taken by a bereaved mother.

Some 1000 Nassau county police and volunteers have searched for the child since he disappeared from in front of a supermarket Monday afternoon.

Nationalist China Stages Mock Battle

Taipei, Formosa - (U.P.) - Nationalist China showed off its armed might on the offshore island of Quemoy Tuesday in a large-scale air, sea and ground war exercise within miles of the Communist coast.

A wing of jet planes and a great number of naval ships and foot soldiers plus an array of U.S.-built heavy weapons, took part in the war games, according to official reports.

The highlight of the mock war centered on a beachhead landing exercise.
