## Pakistan To Seek Meeting on Kashmir

Karachi, Pakistan — (U.P.) — Prime Minister Chaudri Mohamad Ali will seek a "final" meeting with Indian Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru on the Kashmir issue before submitting the controversy once again to the United Nations, government sources said today.

This meeting, sources said, was one of "certain conclusions on initial steps" Ali has decided should be taken to strengthen Pakistan's efforts to obtain a plebiscite in predominantly Muslim Kashmir to decide whether it should be a part of Pakistan or India.

Consult Your Doctor Concerning Frigidity

Fear of sex, which often leads to frigidity in women, needs professional treatment. It should



be taken seriously as it is the basis of many unhappy marriages and divorces.

(Q) "I am a woman of 50, the mother of one daughter and two grandchildren whom my husband and I both adore. However, all my life I have had a fear and resentment of life itself, primarily of sex. My dear, patient husband has been cheated out of a normal married life. He knows how I shrink from him and yet I sincerely love him. I have had several nervous breakdowns and am constantly in a terrible mental conflict. By prayer, I have been 'released' for a time but my mind sooner or later sinks into the old rut. Now I have had change of life and I wonder if this will make me even worse than before. Lately I have felt a certain coolness on my husband's part and this worries me, though I really don't blame him for feeling as he does. What would you advise me to do?"

Mrs. J. R.

(A) I would advise you to consult your doctor at once about this matter and, if he recommends that you see a psychiatrist, do so. You need professional help to overcome the unfavorable attitudes you now have.

The menopause, or change of life, usually has just the opposite effect on women than one would expect. You cannot, therefore, blame any coolness or frigidity you experience on the fact that your body has changed and you are no longer able to produce children.

Not Fair to Him  
Your husband may have been patient with you throughout the years of your marriage, but you, yourself, realize that you have not been fair to him. Furthermore, there is no guarantee that he will continue to be as patient and understanding as he has in the past.

Now that your daughter is married and one of his major responsibilities has ended, he may decide that he wants to have some "fun" out of life before he is too old to enjoy himself. That may be back of his recent coolness. You should regard it as a danger signal.
