

Oregon Power Failure Mystery

Portland — (U.P.) — Bonneville Power Administration officials were "in the dark" today as to the cause of a power failure over a large area of western Oregon yesterday afternoon.

The failure came about 1:30 p.m. and knocked out about 80 per cent of the power supply in the Willamette valley. Affected were systems in Eugene, McMinnville, Forest Grove, Bandon, Drain and Canby; and PUDs and co-ops including Clatskanie, Benton-Lincoln, Central Lincoln, Blachly-Lane, Coos-Curry, Douglas, Lane county, Salem and West Oregon.

Portland's major power distributors also were hit.

Cutages ranged from seconds to minutes with the entire trouble lasting about an hour.

John P. Jolliffe, BPA chief of operations and maintenance, said "We are completely in the dark at the moment as to the cause." He added the cause would not be known until more complete reports were in from control centers and oscillograph records could be determined.

Hospitals and radio stations went onto emergency power supplies but the outage snarled traffic by affecting signals, stopped elevators, halted clocks and caused other inconveniences.

French Flying Saucer Said Actually Meteor

Paris — (U.P.) — Pierre Danjon, Paris observatory director, said today the "flying saucer" which swept across French skies Thursday was actually a meteor, "but what a meteor."

"It was without doubt the most magnificent aerolite I have ever seen in all my career," he said. Appearance of the meteor started rumors that a flying saucer had sped across the sky. "It was a wonderful color of emerald green and extremely bright," Danjon said.

November is Pie Baking Time

Rich, spicy airs of pumpkin pie and sage dressing will soon be filling kitchens once again. Let your family gather to the finest fall meals yet—meals topped off with pies whose crusts melt in your mouth.



Good pie crust is no accident. It's the result of good ingredients (Oregon soft wheat flour) and a good recipe.

BASIC PIE CRUST

Sift together: 1 cup sifted enriched all-purpose or pastry flour, 1/2 teaspoon salt. Cut in until mixture forms particles the size of small peas. 1/4 cup cold shortening. Sprinkle 2 tablespoons cold water over the flour mixture and blend with a fork. Form into ball with hands and flatten into large circle. Roll out to size of pan plus 1". Ease into pan with extra fullness. Fold excess under pan edge.



Flute by grasping edge of crust with thumb and forefinger of left hand. Place thumb and forefinger of right hand 1/2" to the right and make pinch by bringing hands together. Move left hand one flute to right and continue pinching around pan. Make fork marks over entire pan on bottom and sides. Bake at 450° for 12-15 min.

FOR DOUBLE CRUST

Double amount of basic pie crust recipe. Roll out half of pie dough to size of pan. Place in pan and trim off excess at edge. Roll out top crust 1/2" larger than pan. Brush edge of bottom crust with cold water. Place desired filling in lined pan. Cover with top crust. Tuck upper crust under lower crust and flute as for pie shell.

ARE YOUR CRUSTS SHRINKING?

A well-shaped crust calls for practice and planning. When placing crust in pan, ease in and provide extra fullness to avoid shrinking. Follow your recipe... too much water will cause a crust to shrink. Let it "rest" before trimming and fluting. Pastry flour is blended just right to give you a flour that can be "worked with" more.

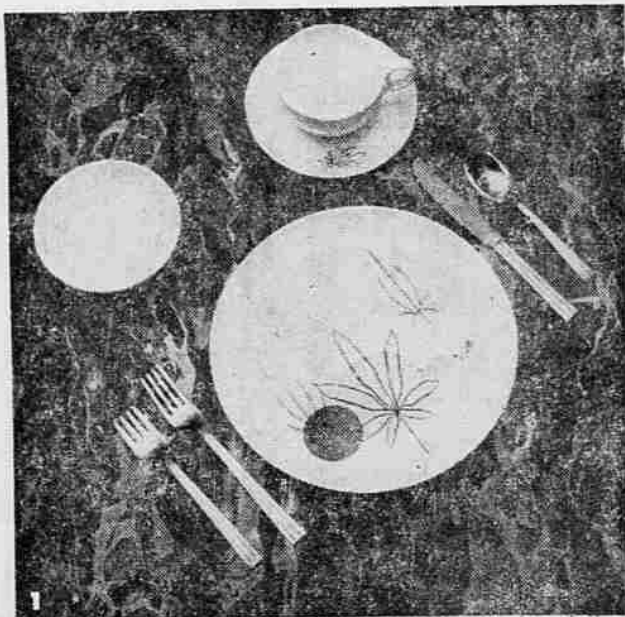

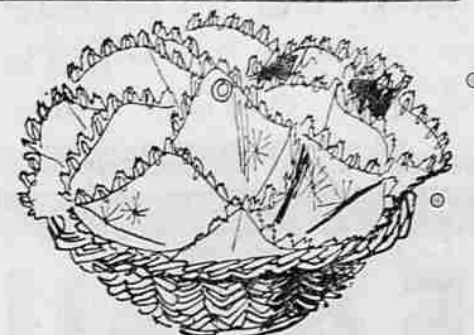
