Amsterdam — (U.P.) — On my word of honor, azynzurhoute-nankeerafluitpin, is a word! A Dutch word, meaning a peg made of a particular kind of wood.
On a quick trip through Amsterdam I learned many interesting things. There are 65 miles of canals and 460 bridges, twice as many as in Venice. Two cars per week fall into canals because they park along the sides. Flags on the flagpoles in every square are usually at half-mast, indicating there has been another fatal auto accident that day.

It is rare for married women to work, except in their own homes, which are kept immaculately clean. I'm sure they are the cleanest in the world. The stairs in all but the newest buildings are almost like ladders—so steep and narrow that all the houses have a large hook on the uppermost beam protruding from the roof. This way furniture and large packages can be hoisted through windows.

Need for Children
I heard a great deal about the housing shortage but also heard that the queen gives each child of a "salaried" papa 41 guilders quarterly, approximately \$60 a year. For each additional child he gets a larger amount. One actor has nine children.

Former Rommel Korp Members Honor Dead

Tobruk, Libya — (U.P.) — Four hundred former members of Field Marshal Erwin Rommel's Afrika Korps gathered in this dusty port Sunday to honor the memory of Germans who fell in the North African campaigns of World War II.

A little further on I noticed a three-story building about 16 feet wide with these words over the door, "Hotel New York." "On the left," our guide went on, "is the smallest house in Amsterdam. I imagine in the world." It is two stories, has three rooms, only 32 inches wide, the width of an ordinary door. I saw a fat man sitting in the upstairs window.

The most wonderful thing I heard in Amsterdam, or any country for that matter, was that children and young people under 21 are not allowed to sit on a street car or public conveyance if an adult, man or woman, is standing.

Soviet Leaders Told India Not Taking Sides in Cold War

New Delhi — (U.P.) — Indian Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru told visiting Soviet leaders Sunday night his country is not taking sides with them in the cold war.

"India is in no camp and in no military alliance," he said in a speech before visiting Soviet Premier Nikolai Bulganin and Communist party boss Nikita S. Khrushchev.

Bulganin addresses the Indian Parliament today. He is expected to enunciate the Soviet attitude toward international and especially Asian affairs and economic cooperation.

Wants Camp of Peace
"The only camp we should like to be in is the camp of peace and good will which should include as many countries as possible and which should include as many countries as possible and which should be opposed to none," Nehru said.

The Indian premier said he felt the field of cooperation between India and the Soviet Union was rich and wide and expressed hope the visitors would help in the process of deeper understanding and cooperation.

Bulganin, also addressing the banquet held in his honor at India's presidential palace, said despite failure of the Geneva conference, Russia is certain the four powers will succeed in solving the problems facing them.

He commended the "Geneva spirit as the best hope for peace in the world."

Cranmore, County Galway, Ireland — (U.P.) — The 300 residents of this tiny village got their pint of porter at the old price of 17 cents today after boycotting all six pubs in the area.

Baltimore, Md. — Gov. Theodore R. McKeldin on desegregation of the Maryland National Guard, the first such action by any state south of the Mason-Dixon line:
