No Court Martial For Overseas Wives

Washington — (U.P.) — A federal judge ruled yesterday that wives accompanying their servicemen husbands overseas cannot be tried by a military court martial.

U.S. District Judge Edward A. Tamm declared unconstitutional a section of the 1950 uniform code of military justice giving courts martial jurisdiction over "persons accompanying the armed forces without the continental limits of the United States."

He handed down the ruling in ordering Mrs. Clarice B. Covert of Atlanta, Ga., freed on a habeas corpus writ from District of Columbia jail, where she has been held awaiting an Air Force court martial in the ax-killing of her husband.
