

Religious Leaders Appeal to Benson To Release Food

Washington — (U.P.) — U.S. religious leaders have appealed personally to Secretary of Agriculture Ezra T. Benson to release more of the government's hoard of surplus foods for relief shipments to hungry families overseas.

Benson promised church spokesmen at an unpublished meeting here earlier this month that he would take a "good, hard look" at their request. An Agriculture Department spokesman said today it is "still under study." He said it may be necessary to ask Congress for special legislation.

Congress authorized Benson last year to give away some surplus farm commodities for distribution abroad by private relief agencies. But Agriculture Department attorneys have interpreted this law to mean that free allocations can be made only when products are in danger of spoiling in storage. Under this interpretation, the only types of food released so far have been dairy products — dried milk, butter, and cheese, and cottonseed oil.

About \$50,000,000 worth of these foods has been distributed to the needy in 20 countries this year by such organizations as Church World Service, Catholic War Relief services, the American Friends Service Committee, the American-Jewish Joint Distribution Committee, and CARE.

Harriman Gets Political Backing Of Immigration Act Co-Sponsor

Washington — (U.P.) — New York Gov. Averell Harriman today gained a congressional supporter in his expected bid for the Democratic presidential nomination.

Rep. Francis E. Walter (D-Pa.), who broke with Adlai E. Stevenson in the 1952 campaign over the McCarran-Walter Immigration Act, announced his support for Harriman. Walter said he expects to go to the Democratic national convention next August as a "Harriman delegate."

Walter, chairman of the House Un-American Activities Committee, said Harriman "is the only candidate" for the Democratic nomination who "has true appreciation of the No. 1 problem confronting the nation today — the threat to our security posed by the Russians who are intent on world domination."

Walter broke with Stevenson in 1952 when the former Illinois governor criticized and called for liberalizing the immigration act which Walter sponsored with the late Sen. Pat McCarran (D-Nev.).

When Stevenson announced his candidacy for the Democratic nomination again next year, Walter denounced him as "the laughing boy of American politics."

He said it was "inconceivable" the Democrats would choose Stevenson, considering the number of "outstanding Americans" available. In other political develop-

ments Democrats continued their sharp blasts at the administration's farm program and the defunct Dixon-Yates power contract.

Murder Rules Out In Death of Three

Powell River, B. C. — (U.P.) — An autopsy has ruled out the possibility of murder in the deaths of a Portland logger and two other lumber workers 30 miles north of here last Thursday.

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police said Charles Haines, 34, Portland; Fred Jennings, 40, Vancouver, B. C., and Uno Nylund, 55, Courtenay, B. C., died of drowning during a raging storm.

The loggers drowned in Galley Bay, 30 miles north of Powell River, while rowing their boat across a 40-yard stretch of water. They were employees of the Glen Levitt Logging Co. and were rowing their boat from a logging company dininghouse on a float in the bay to their bunkhouse on another float.

The bodies of Haines and Jennings were recovered and an autopsy ordered after an unidentified man told mounted police that he thought he "might have" murdered the trio.

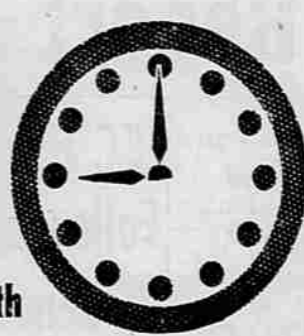
Walla Walla Prison Escapee Captured

Portland — (U.P.) — William Paul Lee, about 43, one of 10 prisoners who escaped from the Washington state penitentiary Nov. 3, was in custody here today.

Lee is the last of the escapees to be picked up. He was arrested by FBI agents in northwest Portland last night, according to Joseph A. Santoliana Jr., special agent in charge of the Portland office.

Santoliana said Lee was being held on a warrant charging unlawful flight to avoid prosecution and would be turned over to Washington authorities.

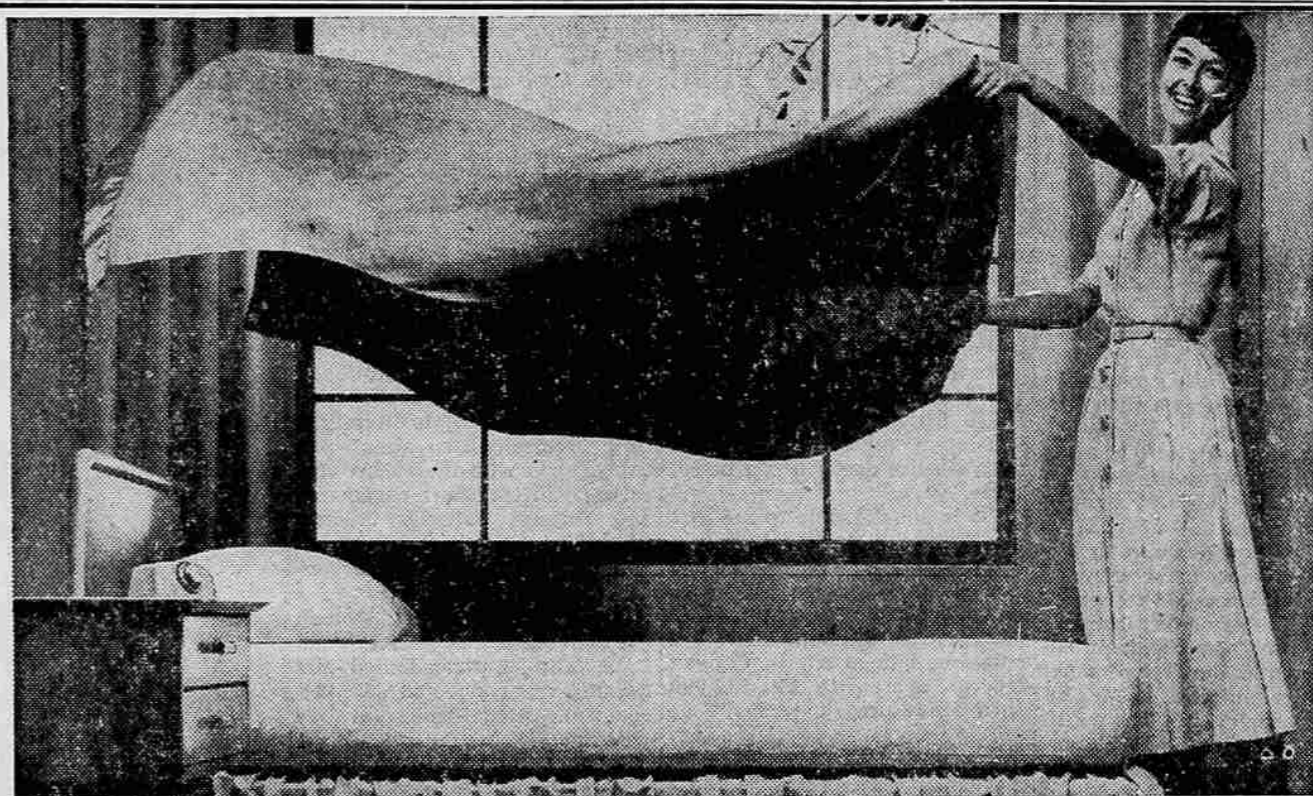
Lee was picked up in a rooming house where he was staying while hunting a job. He offered no resistance.

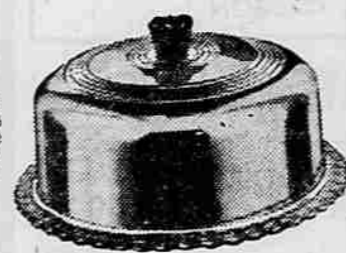
