

### Second Member Quits Portland E-R Group

Portland — (U.P.) — John T. Carson today resigned from the Portland Exposition - Recreation commission, calling it "the chloroform committee."

Carson was the second member to leave the trouble-plagued commission in 10 days. Earlier, Chairman James H. Polhemus had resigned.

Carson declared that it was only a matter of time before the commission approved the South auditorium site in downtown Portland and that he did not wish to be identified with such a move.

Both Carson and Polhemus favored the Delta Park site for the proposed \$8,000,000 exposition center but that location was rejected by the Portland city council.

### Sand Control Project Sought by Neuberger

Washington — (U.P.) — Sen. Richard L. Neuberger (D-Ore.) has asked the bureau of the budget to include a request for a sand control project at Florence, Ore., in the budget for the next fiscal year.

Neuberger's office here said he had requested an allocation of \$30,000 to be used by the U. S. Forest Service in planting Holland grass on drifting sand dunes near the mouth of the Siu-slaw river at Florence.

The Oregon Democrat said drifting dunes were encroaching on valuable timber land, engulfing farm land, and threatening to choke the harbor entrance and cover U. S. Highway 101.
