Around Hollywood

Hollywood —U.P.—Television used to be a forbidden word in movie circles, but these days movie-makers are cornering the year's best TV stories, actors and writers.

Next year the same stories seen at home on TV will wind up in glorious Cinemascope, color, etc., in the theaters.

Producer Burt Lancaster started it all by making a movie hit of a TV story by Paddy Chayevsky, "Marty." Now MGM has three TV dramas in its movie mill.

Vidal Pens Screenplay

Gore Vidal, another top TV writer, was hired to pen a screenplay of Chayevsky's popular video play, "A Catered Affair." The original author also arrived at MGM to help with the script, which stars Bette Davis.

TV writer Rod Serling parlayed his scripts into a triple-play. He was hired by MGM to write a screenplay of a magazine story, "Fifty-two Miles to Terror." MGM also is filming his "The Pack," starring Paul Newman, an actor discovered on TV. Next month Serling will write another of his hit TV plays, "The Shrike" as an MGM film.

Independent producer Michael Myerberg already has produced a movie from Serling's TV drama that won the Sylvania Award last week, "Patterns."

Myerberg also plans to make a movie next year of another Serling teleplay, "Incident in an Alley."

Serling Boosts Salary

Serling is an example of the young TV talent hurtled into big movie money overnight. He is only 31 (Vidal is 30, Chayevsky 34). The three writers are good-looking enough to be actors, and look young enough to be sharpening pencils as script boys instead of writing big-league movies.

Only five years ago Serling sold his first teleplay for \$100. He wrote dramas at a Cincinnati TV station before moving to New York. As he says, "When I went into TV it was a step-child—now it's a real art form."
