

Preliminary Probe Completed In Affairs Of Ex-Social Worker

A preliminary field investigation of the activities of Harley L. Heubner, a former social worker for the Jackson County Public Welfare department, has been completed, it was announced Saturday by County Judge Rodney Keating, co-chairman of the local welfare commission.

He made the announcement in the absence of Alfred S. V. Carpenter, chairman of the commission.

Heubner was convicted last month of passing a check with insufficient funds. Investigation of the circumstances of this violation led to the discovery that he had also misappropriated welfare department funds, according to District Attorney Walter Nunley. The investigation was to determine the extent of his actions in this regard, Judge Keating explained.

Assigned to Investigate

In charge of the investigation is William Smythe, director of field service for the state public welfare department. He was assigned to the job by Mrs. Lo Howard Mason, state administrator, when Heubner's activities became known.

Findings of the investigation will be considered by the state commission, and the local welfare commission is also being kept informed of the findings, Judge Keating said.

Additional work will have to be completed before a final report is made, Judge Keating explained. He said that there have been a number of unsubstantiated rumors regarding the welfare office in Jackson county.

Defense Rests In Sherry Fong Case

Portland (U.P.)—The defense rested Friday afternoon in the first degree murder trial of Sherry Fong, after producing a second witness who testified to seeing Diane Hank alive after the supposed date of her death.

An 18-year-old student nurse, Carol Thompson, said she saw the 16-year-old murder victim crossing a downtown Portland street late in the afternoon of Jan. 7, 1954. The state contends Diane was slain while staying overnight at the Fong residence Jan. 6.

On Wednesday, another former high school classmate of Diane's testified she saw the girl in a department store on Jan. 26, some three weeks after the alleged time of death.

Sherry took the stand in her own defense earlier Friday to declare, "I don't know when she died. I don't know where she died. I just don't know."

Defense Attorney Irvin Goodman dramatically asked the 24-year-old woman: "Did you kill Diane Hank?"

"Absolutely not," Mrs. Fong said.

Mrs. Fong admitted giving the girl vitamin pills on the night of Jan. 6, 1954, because Diane complained of feeling "kind of run down."

The defense rested with the understanding that it can call one more witness, Dr. Howard Richardson, former head of the State Crime Laboratory, if he can be brought from Seattle later.

Grounds Man Sought At VA Domiciliary
