Winner of \$100,000 on TV Quiz Show To Contribute Sums To Three Charities

New York—(U.P.)—Mrs. Ethel Park Richardson, TV's most successful quiz contestant, celebrates her 72nd birthday tomorrow — 14 pounds lighter and \$100,000 heavier.

A folk lore expert, Mrs. Richardson lost the poundage and won the cash on NBC-TV's "The Big Surprise" last Saturday after building up her stake on five previous appearances on the show.

The \$100,000 was the largest prize ever toted away from a give-away show. It topped the \$64,000 won by Marine Capt. Richard McCutchen and psychologist Joyce Brothers on CBS-TV's "The \$64,000 Question."

Mrs. Richardson earned it. "I'm still shaking," she said after the show. "My knees are knocking and all I want to do is go home and to bed. I've lost so much weight on the show, my dresses don't fit me anymore."

Charities Will Benefit

The sprightly great-grandmother, a native of Decherd, Tenn., who now lives in Los Angeles, said she would contribute some of her winnings to three charities. A source close to her said Mrs. Richardson's donation would be substantial, perhaps as much as \$30,000.

Mrs. Richardson also said that some of the money would be used to buy a new car and to send her granddaughter, Karen Hansen of Fresno, Calif., on a trip abroad. Miss Hansen is a student at UCLA.

"I think after taxes are taken out," said Mrs. Richardson, "I'll have about \$28,000 left."

Her question was written by Gov. Goodwin Knight of California. Here are the questions and answers.

1. Name the canal, completed in 1825, which became a highway to the West and was celebrated in folksong—The Erie Canal.
2. Shenandoah is a famous folksong. Who was Shenandoah?—An Indian chief.
3. Name the river mentioned in the folksong "El-a-noy"—the Wabash (also the Ohio).
4. A melody was played on a guitar and Mrs. Richardson was asked to identify it and sing the first verse. "It was 'The Streets of Laredo.'"
5. Name the girl mentioned in the ballad, "The Colorado Trail"—Laura.
6. Again, a melody was played and Mrs. Richardson was asked to sing the verse and chorus. It was "Sacramento."

Mrs. Richardson had some trouble with "The Streets of Laredo." She tackled it three times before she got it right. Afterwards, she explained:

"I've known that song for 100 years. I didn't forget it—the guitar just confused me."
