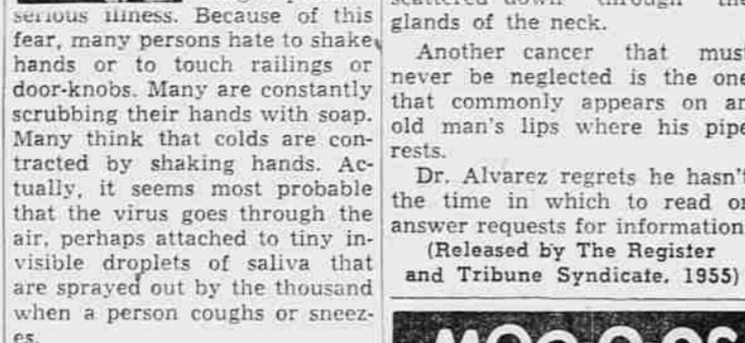

The thing I dread most to do in sub-freezing weather is to get into a warm and tightly closed taxicab with a driver who is sniffing and coughing and sneezing with an acute cold. Some of the worst colds I have ever had I have caught in this way.

Many persons keep trying to disinfect their mouth or throat with washes and gargles, but most such fluids have only a slight cleansing effect. They cannot be expected, in a minute, to destroy germs. Some people take more both than the skin can stand. The skin may get rough and itchy because of the washing off of its natural oil. Hence many wise persons, especially in winter, use but little soap and after a bath they rub some oil or cold-cream into the skin.

Air Filled With Germs

All of us might as well face the fact that the air about us is filled with germs and viruses, and there is no way of avoiding them. Fortunately, those of us who are healthy have enough resistance in our body, so that we don't get into trouble. Some of us have more resistance than others. For instance, when I was a strong athletic lad, I had four awful colds a year, but now that I am older and apparently much more resistant, I rarely get a bad cold. My father, who did not look strong, practically never had a cold. His natural resistance must have been very high.

All persons should remember that drying kills millions of the harmful germs about us and sunlight kills millions more. Persons should remember, also, that the worst germs are found around a hospital. People with abscesses and pneumonias and serious infections bring bad germs into a hospital. When I was a young man practicing in a mining camp high up in the mountains, I could do safely all sorts of things, such as confining a woman in a dirty shack, or injecting medicine hypodermically in a hurry, before I could even wash my hands.

I could do these things safely . . . why? Because the germs that lived out in that mountain region seemed to be largely harmless ones.

I think it should greatly encourage all worrisome persons to learn that we physicians and even those of us who, in a big city hospital, each year treat thousands of persons with terrible infections, are not more subject to infection with germs than are many other persons. I remember a month, 50 years ago when I worked day and night in the Contagious Pavilion of a big city hospital. Although surrounded on all sides by persons (often dying) with diphtheria, blood poisoning, erysipelas, scarlet fever, small pox, and meningitis, I did not catch anything.

Whenever a person past middle age gets a little scabby spot or ulcerating nodule on his face, a spot which tends to keep breaking open, or which never heals completely, he should go immediately to a good skin specialist who can usually destroy the thing in a minute with the

## Moscow Reports Arrest Of Bishop

London—(U.P.)—Radio Moscow reported Saturday that Kung Pin-Mei, Catholic bishop of Communist-held Shanghai, and his "principal accomplices" were arrested two months ago as spies and subversive plotters.

The broadcast, quoting press reports from Red Peiping, said secret police who arrested the bishop and his aides captured radio equipment and papers proving they were working for Free China and "certain foreign powers."

It charged also that they were "plotting a counter-revolutionary uprising."

The radio report did not say how many persons were arrested, where they were being held, or when they will be tried. It was assumed here that the "accomplices" it mentioned were Chinese churchmen.

Informed sources here said the Bishop's arrest may mark the beginning of a Communist crackdown on native priests in conquered China, who have been generally exempt from the persecution suffered by foreign missionaries.

Kung, who also uses the christian name Ignatius, was born 54 years ago in the Chinese village of P'ou-ton, near Shanghai. He was ordained a priest in 1930 and consecrated a bishop in 1949.

In addition to his duties as Bishop of Shanghai, he is Apostolic Administrator of Nanking
