Too Early To Tell About Tax Slices, Key Democrats Say

Washington (U.P.)—Two key Democrats on the tax-writing House Ways and Means Committee said today that it's too early yet to tell whether there can be a net reduction in taxes next year.

They declined to join Sen. Walter F. George (D-Ga.) in painting a rosy outlook on chances of tax relief next year. George said Monday he believed the treasury could stand a tax cut of \$3,000,000,000 to \$3,500,000,000 in the fiscal year starting next July 1.

Rep. Hale Boggs (D-La.) said he agreed with the stand taken by Rep. Wilbur Mills (D-Ark.) that Congress should put off until spring a final decision on a cut in taxes.

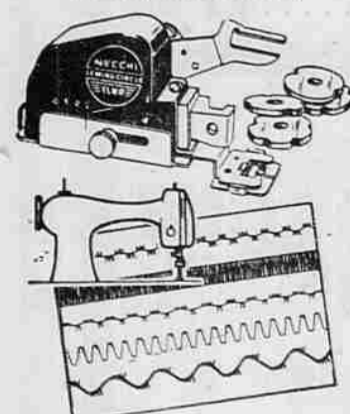
Speculation Refused
The White House also refused to speculate on tax reduction, although President Eisenhower and Republican congressional leaders were told Monday the outlook is hopeful for balancing the budget in the current fiscal year without cutting military spending.

Boggs is a vice-chairman of the Democratic National Committee as well as a member of the House Ways and Means committee. Mills is chairman of a joint congressional economic subcommittee studying tax policy and is second-ranking Democrat on the Ways and Means committee, which initiates all tax legislation.

George has long had a major voice in tax matters as a member of the Senate Finance committee which considers tax bills after they are approved by the House.

Earlier this year, George joined in helping the administration kill in the Senate a \$20-per-person income tax cut which Mills and Boggs and other Democrats pushed through the House. But Monday George said he thought the budget finally could be brought into balance by June and that income taxes could be lowered without putting the government back into the red.

George said he favored using the first \$2,500,000,000 of any tax cut to increase personal income tax exemptions from the present \$600 to \$700. If additional tax relief is possible, he said, he favored reducing rates for middle income brackets.

Plane Can Be Flown With Periscope Use

Champaign, Ill. (U.P.)—A pilot can fly a plane by looking through a periscope.

The experiment which proved it could be done was made at the University of Illinois aviation psychology laboratory. The project was another in the nine-year history of the laboratory which is exploring the human element in aviation.

The periscope experiment points to the future when the canopy bubble of the pilot's cockpit will give way to improved streamlining.

The laboratory, at the university's own airport, is the only facility of its kind in the country, University of Illinois officials say. It works out problems for the Air Force, the Navy and private industry. Some examples include:

The Illinois system of flight training which uses a Link Trainer to give early instruction so pilots can have more time in the air during advanced training.

A study of how many airplanes a traffic controller can safely keep track of at one time on a radar screen.

A new project to test whether cost of training pilots can be cut by using full-size photographic enlargements of a cockpit to teach the location and use of instruments.

Store Sells Things For Good Deeds

Chicago (U.P.)—A store that sells things for good deeds instead of money opened recently under the sponsorship of the Old Town-Chicago Boys Clubs with about 1,000 neighborhood boys as members.

If a boy wants to buy a pair of gym shoes, for instance, he may pile up credit tokens in a variety of ways—by washing floors, emptying waste baskets, running errands, aiding in the city's current cleanup campaign, or even by improving his grades at school.

The credits will buy goods ranging from bicycles to cans of pork and beans.

"There are a lot of poor kids in our neighborhood," said Vince Giesler, club director. "Instead of just giving the stuff away, we're making them work for it. Nothing destroys the dignity of a boy so much as to accept handouts."

David X. Meyers, garage owner and chairman of the board of the club, said merchandise for the store was donated by local businessmen.
