The Medical Roundup

SOME UNHAPPINESS OF SICK PEOPLE An intelligent and thoughtful woman writes saying that "Socialized medicine is certain to come if you doctors, the medical schools and the professional associations do not soon recognize the frustrations, fears, uncertainties, and dissatisfactions of many patients. I do wish you would discuss these problems with which we are faced now that the costs of illness are becoming so frightening, and the men and women working in clinics and hospitals are often so curt, cold, distant, unsympathetic and apparently unfriendly."

Often the poor lonely patient gets the feeling that the activities of the medical and nursing staffs are so secret and un-touchable that he dare not even ask a question about his findings and his fate. Since we patients are paying the bills, we feel that the doctors should recognize the immediate need for many improvements in the mental and physical handling of patients. Medical organizations and the managers of hospitals and clinics ought to be insisting that something be done to improve matters.

True: Today many good physicians everywhere, and heads of most medical organizations are much concerned over these problems, and wish they could do something to correct the abuses. The trouble is that one cannot put sympathy, kindness, courtesy and tact into a person who hasn't these qualities and does not care to acquire them.

Commonly, today, the persons who write me about their unhappy experiences with apparently heartless physicians, nurses or desk-girls, say that if we in medicine do not mend our ways we soon will be punished by the imposition on us of socialized medicine. This may be true, but I just cannot see how this can be expected to give patients a kinder and more personal type of practice. It should do just the reverse.

One day, when in a foreign land, I watched a physician attend to perhaps 40 persons in 2 hours. He did not greet them or even look at them. He read on a card, prepared by a nurse, such words as "cough," "constipation," "indigestion" and then he wrote on the card 55 or 72—a designation for a medicine.

He was a good, kindly man who so disliked this heartless and unscientific and unsatisfactory assembly-line type of medicine.
