The Medical Roundup

RHEUMATOID ARTHRITIS IN PIGS. Many persons ask me if research is being done on arthritis, and, of course, much is being done.

Dr. G. M. Neher, of Purdue, told the group that arthritis appears commonly in pigs after an attack of swine erysipelas. Following up this observation, Dr. Neher and his associates injected 291 pigs with a germ and in a high percentage of the animals they were able to produce a disease resembling rheumatoid arthritis.

Interestingly, the rheumatoid disease in pigs responds well to cortisone and ACTH. It is very encouraging to know that at least a serious type of arthritis can be studied in animals. It is helpful, also, to know that a disease that looks like rheumatoid arthritis can be due to a reaction to a bacterium.

Mental illness. I was much pleased to find in Science News Letter that Jane Stafford, the prize-winning science-writer, told members of the National Association for Mental Health at their recent meeting that today one can hardly find a newspaper or magazine that hasn't some note or article on mental disease.

Then they first vaccinated the animals against the infection and, after that, the germs produced arthritis in 100 per cent of the pigs. This observation reinforces a hunch we physicians have long had that several chronic diseases are due to the action of an infection on the arteries of a person who is first sensitized or made allergic to the germ.

Schrunk Removal Ruled by Thornton

Salem — (U.P.) — Attorney-General Robert Y. Thornton said Friday that it was his opinion present law requires Gov. Paul Patterson to remove Multnomah County Sheriff Terry Schrunk from office.

Thornton added, however, that he didn't think the law was constitutional. Gov. Paul L. Patterson withheld comment until he had more time to study the attorney general's opinion.

The law requires the governor to declare vacant the office of a public official under bond who suffers a damage judgment against him. Schrunk recently lost a civil suit for damages for alleged failure to serve a court summons before the statute of limitations expired.

All Oregon Counties Now Disaster Areas

Washington—(U.P.)—The small Business Administration said Friday that all counties in Oregon and Washington are now designated as disaster areas as a result of a damaging freeze Nov. 11-14 that caused substantial losses to the nursery industry.

On Dec. 20 counties in western Washington and 18 in western Oregon were designated disaster areas. Friday's action extends the designation to the eastern parts of the states.
