A reply brief in the appeal of the James Norman Jensen case was filed Friday by Edward C. Kelly, attorney for the defense.

Kelly's brief was in reply to one filed Oct. 24, 1955, by District Attorney Walter Nunley. The state supreme court will set a date for argument.

Jensen was convicted in 1954 of the murder of Mrs. Fern Hyle, Medford housewife, and sentenced to die in the Oregon state gas chamber. A notice of appeal, filed by Jensen, acted as a stay of execution.
