Peck never admitted right up to the day of the ceremony that he planned to marry the French newspaper writer, although she'd been his companion for two years.

The tall star and Veronique Passani drove with his mother and stepfather to a little town near his ranch in the Santa Ynez Valley for the ceremony.

Only a few of his ranch friends attended. After a New Year's Eve party, the Pecks drove to his simple house on his cattle ranch for a two-day honeymoon. This week he was back at work in his first movie job in 11 months.

"We wanted to have it quiet," was his understatement.

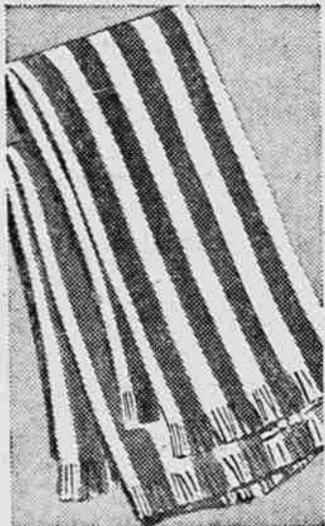
LIBRARY PENALTY

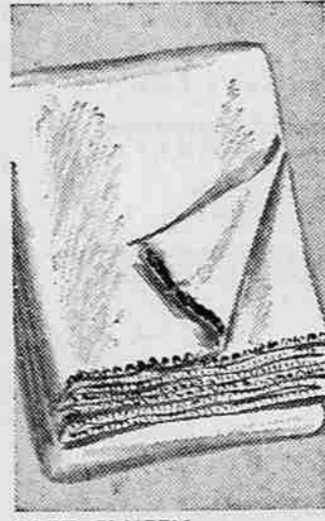

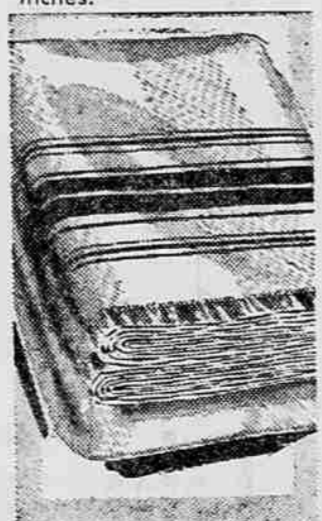

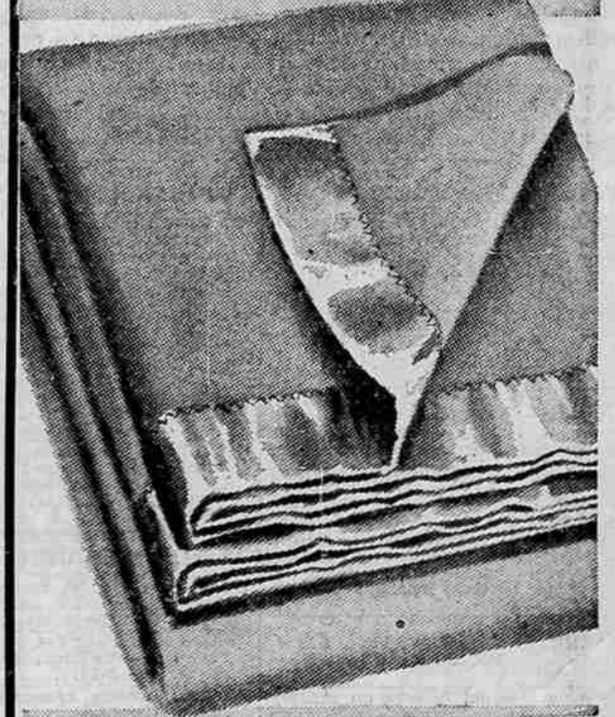
