

## 'Sky-Hops' Greet Hungry Fliers at Nation's First 'Fly-In' Restaurant

Atlanta, Ga.—(U.P.)—A man in Augusta, Ga., is keeping up with the airborne-age with a "Fly-in" restaurant . . . which he claims is the nation's first.

Instead of a "drive-in" for motorists, it's a "Fly-in" for pilots. And instead of "car-hops" there are pretty "sky-hops."

The modern glassed-in restaurant, owned by Grady Timmerman, is in one corner of Daniel Air Field here. When pilots of small planes taxi down the runway to the restaurant, an alert "sky-hop" with a smile comes out to get the pilot's order. She is a member of the "Royal Order of Sky-Hops" distinguished by an insignia on her blouse—stainless steel wings on crossed knives and forks.

**Idea out of Blue**  
Where did the idea come from for a "Fly-in?" Right out of the blue, of course. . . in the form of a hungry pilot. During the construction of Timmerman's restaurant, a pilot taxied his plane over and suggested that he serve chow to the fly boys who "are always in a hurry." Thus, America's first "Fly-in" became a reality.

Pilots who use Daniel field for a rest stop can refuel themselves, as well as their planes. And someday a billboard may grace the airways saying—"Stop at the Pilots' Refueling Station—Timmerman's restaurant."

### Around Hollywood

Hollywood—(U.P.)—Deborah Kerr, the one-time prim dramatic actress, is singing for the first time for a living—but she's one star who admits she has a part-time "double" in the voice department.

The redhead floored moviegoers before when she showed up as a sexy "other woman" in "From Here To Eternity." Now she's joined Marlon Brando, Susan Hayward and other stars who've switched to singing. Deborah will surprise fans again as the singing school-teacher in one of 1956's biggest musicals, "The King and I."

But the voice you'll hear doing the Rogers and Hammerstein songs won't be entirely her own.  
**Split Songs**  
The low notes in most of the songs are Deborah's. The high notes, in the same tunes, were taken over by singer Marni Nixon—Hollywood's first case of 50-50 warbling. Usually when a voice is dubbed, as in "Carmen Jones," the behind-scenes singer does all the work.

"Before I started the picture I made a record for the studio and I tried to be objective about my voice," the actress explained as she crawled out of her hoop skirts in her dressing room.

"Some of the songs I could do, but some I couldn't because they had an operatic range. I wanted to do as much myself as I could. So the studio found a singer whose voice matches mine."

The actress sings two songs entirely by herself—"Whistle A Happy Tune" and "Shall I Tell You." The other four, including "Hello, Young Lovers," are part Deborah's voice and part Miss Nixon's on the sound track.

"I took singing lessons for several weeks last year but I had to stop while I did another picture at Paramount," the actress went on. "If I had had more time to prepare, I may have been able to sing all the songs."

**Maybe Nightclubs**  
Miss Kerr claims she was the first dramatic star to be signed for a singing role, as she agreed to do the lavish musical two years ago. Her first reaction was, "Oh, Lord, I can't sing."

"Before this I had sung only in the bath," she laughed, pronouncing it "bawth."  
Deborah's voice has opened a new career for her. The Sands Hotel in Las Vegas offered her \$100,000 for a singing engagement. And her co-star, Yul Brynner, wants her to tour with him in "The King and I" in Europe after the film is released.

"I may work up a nightclub act," she smiled. "I never say no to anything now. I spent so much of my life believing I was not capable of doing things. But you can do almost anything if you take it seriously. Next I want to do a western—a real sagebrush girl."

## Pope Indorses Painless Childbirth for Catholics

Vatican City—(U.P.)—Pope Pius XII has given permission to Roman Catholic mothers to use modern psychological methods to ease the pains of childbirth.

The pontiff, in a new definition of the church view on childbirth, gave qualified indorsement to the so-called psychoprophylactic method of preparing mothers for childbirth developed by followers of the Russian materialist scientist, Ivan Pavlov.

He said the new techniques of "painless" childbirth do not conflict with Catholic principles.

The pope told 700 Catholic gynecologists from 11 nations that neither the Bible nor the moral doctrine of the church forbid attempts to ease pain in the course of a natural childbirth.

"It is a question here of natural, painless childbirth, in which no artificial means is used, but the mother's natural forces alone are called into action," the pope said.

The statements marked an important change in emphasis in the Vatican's views.
