The Northwest Kiwanis club said today it would undertake to establish an educational trust fund for the boys, Myron Whitcomb, 12; Melvin Weaver, 14; and Lynn Hill, 10.

The boys found the money in May of 1952 in an abandoned fish pond. It was turned over to the sheriff while a friendly suit was filed to establish their right to the money. A Circuit Court ruling gave it to them but the State Supreme Court Wednesday reversed this and said it belonged to the estate of James Stevens, 71, who owned the property and died a few days before
