Food Poisoning One Of Diseases Reported

Six cases of food poisoning were reported in Ashland last week, according to the weekly report of communicable diseases by the Jackson County health department.

Dr. A. Erin Merkel county health officer, said all six cases apparently were in the same family. He said the food poisoning was traced to meat sandwiches, which the family ate one evening. Members of the family were taken sick about 2 a.m. the following morning.

Other communicable diseases reported last week included five fluenza, six chicken pox, two influenza, one pneumonia, one infectious hepatitis and two trench mouth.
