When Blood Vessels Break Under the Skin
Many women are worried because, every so often, a blood vessel appears to break somewhere under the skin, perhaps of the thigh, leaving a big bluish spot which later goes away. In most cases we physicians can't find anything wrong. All we can say is that the patient will probably never come to any bad end. Often it is a good idea to have the blood checked to make sure that there are no abnormalities in the blood-forming organs or in the blood-clotting mechanism. A test can be made to see if the tiny arteries are abnormally fragile. I remember a prominent physician who, for years, had his skin covered with these black and blue spots. He got well when he had a lot of badly infected teeth removed. Severe Mental Disease More Common in Men According to the Metropolitan Life Insurance company, in the one year of 1951, 95,000 males were admitted (for the first time) to mental hospitals, as compared with 76,000 females. About half of these patients were under 45; one in ten was under 25; and 1 in 100 was under 15. The ratio of men to women was to be expected because most severe diseases attack males more often than females. Fortunately in recent years, about three out of four of the patients in some mental hospitals are being released within 3 years.
