Wage, Salary Total Pushed to New High

San Francisco-(U.P.)-Seasonal Christmas hiring pushed the wage and salary employment total in three Pacific Coast states to a new record high of 5,407,800 in December, the U. S. Department of Labor reported today.

The department's bureau of labor statistics reported the increase of 50,000 workers over the previous month put the De-

ember employment figure at less than one per cent below the all-time employment peak of last September.

California recorded a gain of almost five per cent over the previous December and Oregon was up almost three per cent. Despite a seasonal decline, Washington state showed a total figure two per cent higher than the year before.
