Hydradenitis Suppurativa

Some big perfectly healthy men and women suffer from one crop of axillary boils after another. The physician will, of course, always check immediately to see if the person has diabetes, because that might make him more susceptible to boils. Usually, nothing can be found on the examination. Fortunately, today, the taking of one of the stronger antibiotics can help. The local use of one of those antibiotics may also help. I have seen cases so bad that a surgeon had to remove the affected area and transplant skin from some other part of the body.

Drugs Given Just to Please

From the beginnings of time we physicians have given so-called placebos of treatment; often in the form of sugar pills. Usually we have given such remedies rather than to the great trouble of trying to explain to the patient that there was no good known treatment for the particular disease. The patient fully expected to get something in recent years a number of physicians have made a careful study of placebos, recording what they seemed to accomplish, and the results have been astounding. Good old sugar pills have apparently brought quick relief of pain in one-third of the cases; in a third of the cases they have lowered blood pressure, and in 50 per cent of the cases they have appeared to

Don't Force a Choice Between Friends, Family

A husband who expects his wife to give up her friends and devote her entire time to her home and family may discover that she's unwilling to do this.

(A) Make some sort of compromise with your wife so she and the children will come back to you. You were not fair to her when you made her choose between her friends and you. And, because you were trying to cut her off from companionship with the people she liked, she decided to give you up.

Coos Bay Presses For Munitions Depot

Washington —(U.P.)— Sen. Warren C. Magnuson (D-Wash.) has introduced a bill calling for the closure of the Naval Ammunition depot at Fort Chicago, Calif., and transfer of its functions to "a more suitable site, possibly to Bangor, Wash."

Portland —(U.P.)— Circuit Judge James W. Crawford, a veteran of nearly 25 years on the bench, has announced he would be a candidate for reelection in the non-partisan judicial primary May 18.

Connecticut Citizens Use Installment Plan

Chicago —(U.P.)— A growing number of Connecticut municipalities are letting citizens pay their taxes on the installment plan.

The Municipal Finance Officers association, citing a University of Connecticut survey, said that in the 20 years from 1934 to 1954, the number of municipalities having only one tax due date dropped 11.

In 1954, only 81 Connecticut cities or towns had the one due date tax compared with 173 in 1934.

New Type Respirator Breathes Inside Patient

Milwaukee—(U.P.)—A new type of artificial respirator which "breathes" inside the patient was demonstrated here.

Dr. E. Trier Morch of Chicago invented the machine. He said it is one of the first machines which allows the operator to vary the pressure of air intake. Ordinary respirators apply pressure outside the patient.

This allows normal breathing artificially, Dr. Morch said. He demonstrated his machine to the Milwaukee Society of Anesthesiologists.

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
