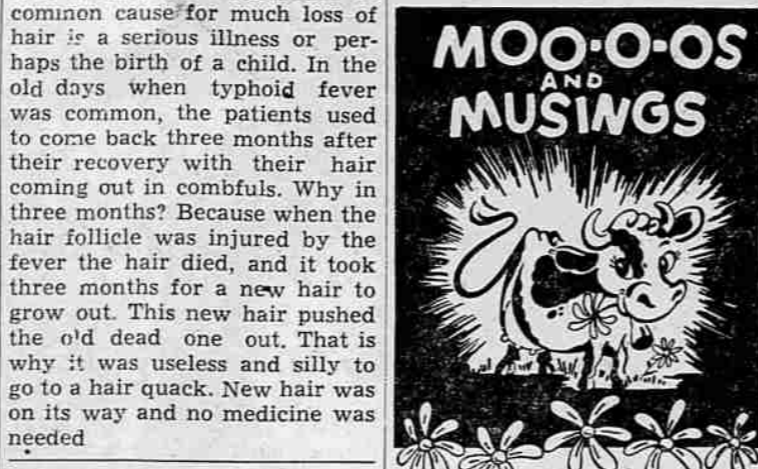

## The Medical Roundup

Women write saying they are losing their hair so much that they fear they will soon go bald. What can they do? To what kind of specialist should they go? Does it pay to go to a hair quack? Will the hair come back? Will vitamins or glandular products help?

Naturally, it is hard to answer all these questions without being able to study the individual. A common cause for much loss of hair is a serious illness or perhaps the birth of a child. In the old days when typhoid fever was common, the patients used to come back three months after their recovery with their hair coming out in clumps. Why in three months? Because when the hair follicle was injured by the fever the hair died, and it took three months for a new hair to grow out. This new hair pushed the old dead one out. That is why it was useless and silly to go to a hair quack. New hair was on its way and no medicine was needed.



Hence it is that anyone who is losing hair should think back to see if, three months before, there was a bad fever or a severe accident. If there was no illness, and if the person has been feeling dull and sleepy and tired he or she should get examined and have the basal metabolic rate checked. It is conceivable that there is some glandular deficiency at work.

## Around Hollywood

Hollywood—(U.P.)—Hollywood is caught in a Bridey Murphy fever—with gags, ads about hypnotists and even one star, Paul Douglas, surpassing them all with a new television series.

Bridey is the subject of a best-selling book on "age regression" hypnosis. A Colorado woman claimed that under hypnosis she discovered she was an Irish girl in another country. Filmites have cottoned to this idea.

One ad in the Hollywood trade papers reads "Reincarnation? Dr. Seide will regress you to establish a life before." The doctor says several movie towners have made appointments to try to find out if they were stars in other centuries.

Past Unfolded  
"One patient discovered she was a horse in 1650," he cried.

Columnists and TV comedians have popped up with such gags as, "Ralph Edwards is doing a TV show on Bridey Murphy called 'This Was Your Life.'" A screen treatment on the book is making the rounds of the studios. But Douglas has beat everyone to the punch by announcing a TV series he claims will put Bridey Murphy in the shade.

Douglas, in association with producer Peter Rathvon and United Press London columnist Robert Mused, secured rights to dramatize the cases of the Society of Psychical Research. This organization since 1882 has collected 80,000 "authenticated cases of psychic phenomenon," such as mental telepathy.

Reincarnation Shunned  
Bridey Murphy-type reincarnation, Douglas says, will not be touched.

"We will not attempt to dramatize anything that it not conclusive," Douglas said. "The society is composed of scientists, professors and learned men. They are very serious. They frown on table moving, mediums. None of that charlatanism. They aren't a bunch of tea leaf boys."

Douglas will host and narrate the series, to be filmed in England beginning in April. The next will be released on TV next fall.

"We'll us English casts," Douglas added. "They are ver cooperative as against the skeptics and scoffers you'd find in Hollywood."
