School Students Learn and Teach Spanish Language

Carmel, Calif.—(U.P.)—Local high school students of the Spanish language not only learn their lessons but teach them as well. Two days a week, for en-

tertaining 20-minute sessions, 13 promising linguists from Carmel High School escape their own classroom chores by journeying to a nearby grammar school where they instruct fifth and sixth-graders in Spanish phrases sayings and songs. And all concerned love it.

The originator of this novel student-to-student basic training method is a young teacher named Donald Craig. His purpose was to see how much of the language elementary students would retain by the time they reached high school if they were given a smattering at a time. And who, he thought, would be better suited to the task of bearing such rudimentary knowledge than his own top pupils?

Now Craig finds his plan to be a pleasant two-way matter. Not only do his better workers deliver bilingual tips to the younger set, but they are also getting a firmer grip on Spanish themselves.

"The old saying is you never really know a thing unless you can teach it to someone else," he said. "My high school class is really getting to know Spanish." Everyone Enthusiastic

Another aspect Craig finds pleasing is the earnestness with which his instruction squad works to put its lessons across. No written Spanish has been shown the younger ones, as phonetic presentation is much more effective on a primary level. This involves the drawing of many colored posters, such as animals and clocks, so the grammar schools students will have something to fall back on when memory fails. All visual aids are put together by the old-

er preppers on their own time. Craig, expressed surprise at the amounts of enthusiasm and leadership ability put forth by his boys. "I figured the girls would really enjoy working with children," he said, "but the boys are much more interested. They provide the leadership."

So far, the students of the students have built an impressive vocabulary of 30 nouns, 16 adjectives, parts of four verbs and 11 colloquial expressions. They also can tell time, count to 1,000 and recite the days and months in Spanish. "The youngsters watch the clock while waiting for their lessons," Craig said, "and when it ends they still want more."
