Mr. Paulson was born in Modesto, Calif., March 31, 1934. He came to Gold Hill with his parents in 1935.

He graduated from the Gold Hill High school in 1951, and attended Southern Oregon college for two years, working part time for the geological survey out of the Medford office.

He enlisted in the Naval Air corps in Aug., 1954, and graduated from Navy pre-flight school at Pensacola, Fla. He received his primary flight training at Whiting Field, Navy auxiliary air station, Pensacola, Fla. He was receiving advanced jet training at Chase Field, Beeville, Tex., at the time of his death. He was making a cross country flight from Chase field to Moffet field, Calif. About 8:30 p.m. near Bakersfield, the electric system of the plane apparently failed at an altitude of about 30,000 feet. The body of Cadet Paulson was found Sunday afternoon.

Survivors include his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Henry M. Paulson; a brother, Elwin Paulson, a sister, Volda Paulson, at home, and grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. D. G. Benton, Modesto, Calif.
