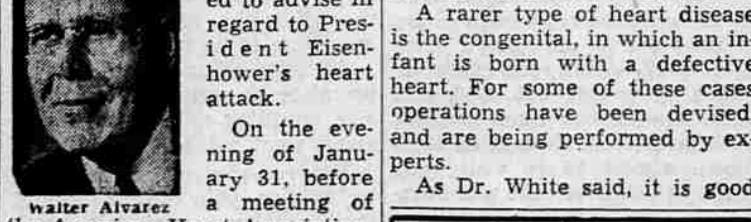

with us as a big problem. But we are learning to recognize more quickly the person who is in danger, and we are learning to treat him more successfully. Today much research is being done with the hope of eliminating the causes of this type of arterial disease of the heart.

When I was an intern, 50 years ago, there were in my wards in the County Hospital many cases of syphilitic heart disease, in which the big aortic valve at the outlet of the heart was seriously damaged.

Forty years or so ago there was a tremendous amount of heart injury due to the then common toxic goiters. Today one sees few toxic goiters and hence few goiter hearts; and when one does see a case, one can quickly help the person.

Coronary heart disease, such as sometimes causes angina pectoris and sudden death, is still

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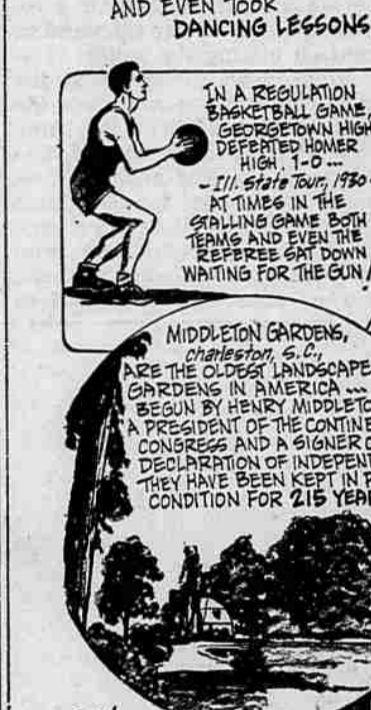

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today to see thousands of generous laymen supplying funds for research and for the training of research workers and heart specialists.

Dr. White said all persons with heart disease who can work should do so. Many could be rehabilitated by experts and put back into industry, and this would be salutary for the patient and splendid for the nation.

SHOULD OBTAIN INFORMATION. The famous specialist said that now much helpful information should quickly be obtained in regard to the diets and conditions of life of those peoples in the world who are largely immune to hardening of the arteries and coronary heart disease.

Indian Artifacts Found in Illinois. Buncombe, Ill.—(U.P.)— Indian artifacts dating back to 2,000 B.C. have been found by a Southern Illinois University museum field group in the Cache River valley about four miles west of this southern Illinois community. Howard Winters, university museum researcher in charge of nine students who worked at the site, said the artifacts were made chiefly of flint. He said the students also uncovered a shallow Indian burial plot. Winters said the materials, found in a cornfield at the confluence of Lick Creek and the Cache River, belong primarily to the late Archaic period of about 2,000 B.C., and to the succeeding woodland culture.
