**Ike's Decision To Bolster Economy**

Washington—(U.P.)—Officials and economists in and out of government said today that President Eisenhower's second term decision will boost "business confidence" and help bolster the economy.

The impact of the announcement on the economy "can only be interpreted on the plus side," a private economist said, since the business world considers Mr. Eisenhower sympathetic to its views.

Officials said they were convinced that the President's "yes" decision was anticipated to a great extent by the stock market. The market greeted the President's announcement by going to new record highs in the heaviest trading in four months.

There was dancing on the floor of the New York Stock Exchange. But prices later fell back and traders grew more cautious until they could learn what conditions Mr. Eisenhower would attach to his willingness to run in his message to the people last night.

The only major condition he mentioned was that he would not be willing to conduct a rigorous, barnstorming-type campaign.

**Russians Informed Of Ike's Decision**

Moscow—(U.P.)—Moscow Radio informed the Russian people last night of President Eisenhower's decision in a one-sentence announcement on the regular 10:30 news broadcast.

The bare announcement said: "Today at his press conference President of the United States of America Eisenhower said he felt able to run for office this year."

The item followed a report from New Delhi on Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru's statement to the Indian Parliament that Mr. Eisenhower had been invited to visit India before he became ill and that the visit now will have to come later.

The manner in which Moscow Radio handled the news was believed to indicate a complete hands off attitude in the matter of the presidential elections.

However, the President's announcement was expected to cause the greatest interest among Soviet leaders who have never concealed their sympathy and respect for Mr. Eisenhower.
