Half of Fatalities Happen at Night

Salem —(U.P.)— More than half of January's 26 fatal traffic accidents in Oregon took place at night, Secretary of State Earl T. Newberry said Saturday.

Most causes boiled down to failure to adjust speed for night driving, the State Traffic Safety office said.

In addition, several of the night crashes might have been averted by January's bad weather—snowy deaths occurred on icy or snowy roads and nine others on wet pavement.

With factors, safety men concluded, could have been overcome if drivers had adjusted speeds to meet conditions.

Sack Case Appeal To Supreme Court

Salem —(U.P.)— The State Supreme Court had at issue Saturday the case of George Sack under death sentence for the slaying of his wife, Goldie, in Portland in 1954.

Sack, a Portland apartment house owner, was convicted of first degree murder in Multnomah county. He appealed to the Supreme Court. The high court will now set a hearing date.

Sack's attorney, John P. Hannon, in filing his reply before the court Friday, alleged the trial court was in error in admitting evidence about the amount of Sack's bank account. Hannon also protested the lower court's failure to grant a directed verdict for his client and the admission of evidence that Sack cashed bonds in February, 1954, for \$10,000. The attorney also said there was no proof that Mrs. Sack's body was seen in the family car on Feb. 16, 1954.

At present, Sack is being held in Rocky Butte jail in Portland pending the Supreme Court hearing of his appeal.

Manila —(U.P.)— The Philippines' mysterious "nightmare" sickness claimed its 15th victim in two months Saturday. The latest victim of the "Bangongot" was a bakery owner in Ilocos Sur province who was found dead yesterday morning by his wife.

Investigators said Pedro Antonio died of the mysterious sickness which claims its victims in their sleep. Laborer Dies Only two days ago the dread-

ed sickness struck in Manila, killing a 26-year-old laborer in his sleep. Dr. Mariano Icasiano, Manila Health department officer, said the victim was found to have died from "acute cardiac and respiratory failure of the Bangongot type."

New York —(U.P.)— Richard Tedeschi told police Friday he tried to stick up a bank because robbery was "my vocation." He walked into a police trap.

Fatal Disease
