## The Medical Roundup

### SHOULD THE SALK VACCINE BE USED?

Many persons keep asking me should they permit the giving of the Salk vaccine to their children. Some of their doctor friends say, "Yes," and some say "No." Who is right? Perhaps the most convincing thing that I can say to these people is that I am advising my children to have my grandchildren protected with the vaccine. It seems to me that today it is safe. Actually, in the last two years it has been remarkably safe in millions of cases. Only in a comparatively few cases was harm done by live virus that got into some ampuls. I feel satisfied that this accident will not be allowed to happen again. That should make the vaccine perfectly safe.

That it protects children from paralytic polio seems to me obvious from the statistics. A glance at the graphs showing the recent big drop in hospital admissions for polio, among children in the age groups in which vaccination was performed, should satisfy most persons. These rates for hospital admissions in 1955 dropped 52 per cent for the eight-year-old group, and 40 per cent for the seven-year-old group. This difference must be compared with the decline of only 17 per cent among the total population.

**Danger To Decrease**  
Naturally, as the vaccination brings down the amount of polio virus in the country, the danger

### Pasha Home From Jordan Arab Legion

London — (U.P.) — Lt. Gen. John Glubb Pasha came home Saturday to a Britain which faced a reappraisal of its shaken position in the Middle East as a result of his ouster as head of the Jordan Arab Legion.

He flew in shortly after Jordan assured Britain that his firing did not mean a break between the two countries.

The 57-year-old Glubb landed at London airport at the end of a long road back from the desert and 30 years of service that brought him fame rivaling that of Lawrence of Arabia.

He called the Arab Legion a "Grand Little Army" and wished it continued success.

He was met at the airport by Maj. Gen. Harold Ryman, representing the Imperial General Staff, and D. S. L. Dobson, private secretary to War Minister Anthony Nutting.

Jordan sought to pacify an angry and disturbed Britain with an official communique that declared it would honor a 1948 treaty of friendship between the two countries.

to all children will decrease, and the rate of infection even for the unvaccinated will decline. Conditions will be much as they are today with diphtheria or typhoid fever. Very few persons now get these diseases because there are so few persons in the nation who can give out the germs. Now that the Salk vaccine is safe and proven effective, I cannot see why children should be denied the protection it gives.

In the latest release from the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis, Dr. Van Riper advised that there be first, two intramuscular injections of one c. c. each, spaced four to six weeks apart. Then it is advisable to have a third or so-called booster injection made some seven months later. The three injections will naturally produce much greater protection than only one injection can give.
