The Woman Who Greatly Wants A Child

Men and women who are very anxious to have a child often ask me if anything can be done when a woman's tubes (that run out on each side from the womb to a point near the ovary) are plugged up or closed. When they are closed, the little ovum or egg cannot get from the ovary to the womb. Usually I fear that nothing can be done. I recently read a report by an expert on the efforts that have been made by surgeons in these cases to open the tubes or to make new ones. The man said that in his experience the results have been poor. One can easily see why, because if a Fallopian tube is to work well the very delicate and specially con-

ward the uterus. Somewhere along the tube the little egg may meet a spermatozoon from the husband, and then a pregnancy can result. The fertilized ovum travels on into the uterus where, if it becomes properly implanted, there it can grow and grow until it becomes a baby.

Tubal Pregnancy

Often times when a tube has suffered some infection and is not quite normal, the fertilized ovum may not go on into the womb and then the woman is likely to have what is called a tubal pregnancy. Because the tube is not big enough or strong enough to hold a growing baby until it comes to term, it usually ruptures, and then if the condition is not quickly recognized, the woman can bleed to death.

In order to find out if her tubes are open a woman can go to a gynecologist who will blow gas into the neck of her womb. Normally this should flow easily into the abdominal cavity. This is the Rubin test.

Tubes Can Be Opened

In some cases in which the tubes are not firmly closed they can be opened up by the blowing of gas through them. If they

are firmly closed, the woman had better start thinking of adopting the child she so greatly wants. In many cities there is a branch of the Planned Parenthood Foundation. They can tell a woman where she can go to get the examination and the advice she needs.
