

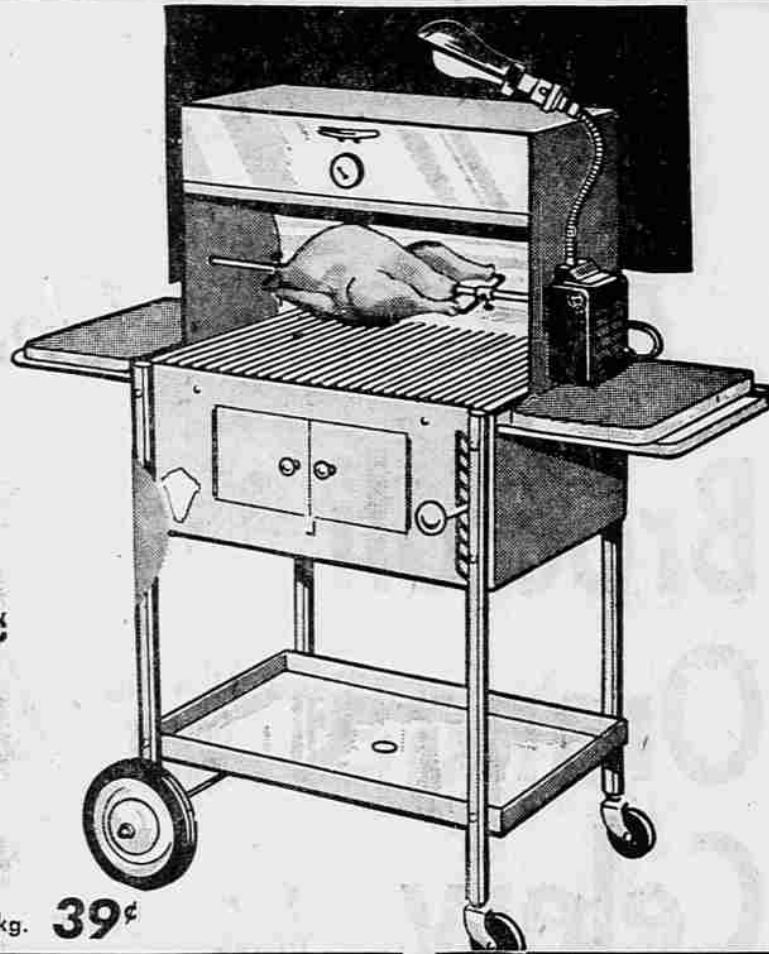

Woman Blames Death Of Husband on Man Talking on Telephone

Fairfax, Calif. — (U.P.) — A grief-stricken widow today blamed the death of her husband on the refusal of a man who shares her party line to let her call for help.
Mrs. Jerry L. Smith said her husband, a 36-year-old restaurant cook, died of a heart attack Sunday night because medical help arrived too late.
The case was similar to that in Miami, Fla., where 86-year-old G. T. Lenelin died after a woman refused to quit talking on a party line while a neighbor tried frantically to call an ambulance.
Mrs. Smith said her husband began suffering chest pains and had difficulty breathing. She called the family doctor in San Rafael. When her husband began to "change color," she went to the telephone again, intending to tell the doctor to hurry.
When she lifted the receiver off the hook to place the call, she heard a man's voice say angrily: "We can't even carry on a conversation without being interrupted!"
Despite her pleas, the man insisted on finishing his conversation before hanging up.
Meanwhile, Smith had grown worse and was near death. Mrs. Smith went again to the telephone to ask the Fairfax Fire Department to send a respirator crew. The line was again busy. Mrs. Smith begged to place a call.
"What are you trying to pull?" "I just gave you the line."
The man then stopped talking, but apparently left the receiver off the hook. Mrs. Smith was unable to get a dial tone. By dint of jiggling the hook frantically for several minutes, she managed to attract the attention of the operator, who placed a call to the fire department.
Too Late
Moments later, the doctor and the fire department arrived, almost together. By then Smith was dead.
Mrs. Smith said she plans to take no legal action.
"I hope whoever did this will be punished most by just learning what he did," she said.
In Miami, police obtained a warrant charging Mrs. Ann Heidenrich, who had refused to get off the line when Lenelin was dying, with disorderly conduct.

Third Fire Victim Found in Rectory

Trenton, N. J. — (U.P.) — Searchers Wednesday night recovered the body of the third victim of a fire that gutted historic St. Mary's Roman Catholic Cathedral and an adjoining rectory.
The body of Miss Mary Brennan, a housekeeper, was found in the charred ruins by workmen after an all day search. The bodies of Msgr. Richard T. Crean, 55, and Miss Mary Duncanson, another rectory housekeeper were found earlier Wednesday.
Msgr. Crean, rector of St. Mary's and vicar general of the Trenton diocese, died in an heroic attempt to warn those in the rectory of the fire.
Police and fire officials today launched a full-scale investigation into the cause of the blaze which destroyed the 85-year-old gothic structure, built on the site where George Washington and the Continental Army defeated British and Hessian troops in the Battle of Trenton in 1776.
The blaze which caused damage estimated at close to \$3,000,000, was detected at 4:30 a.m. by a passerby who turned in an alarm.
Firemen rescued three priests and a rectory cook, all of whom were hospitalized. A fourth clergyman escaped unscathed.
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Horn Tooting Becomes Luxury in New York

New York — (U.P.) — Horn tooting became an expensive luxury in New York City today. The price: \$10 and up.
The luxury pricetag went on honking at 12:01 a.m. as part of a drive to bring quiet to the city's blaring, bustling streets.
Police had orders to hand out summonses to anyone caught tooting a horn. A summons automatically requires a trip to court and a fine ranging from \$10 to \$50.
Mayor Robert F. Wagner proclaimed March 15 "Q-Day" in celebration of the occasion and posed Wednesday with his forefinger to his lips while holding a sign with the legend: "Don't be a Goose! Hold That Honk."
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Officials, Drivers Start Negotiations

San Francisco — (U.P.) — Representatives of union bus drivers and Pacific Greyhound Lines met again today in another attempt to reach agreement on a new contract.
A similar meeting broke up yesterday with no progress reported.
The union claims 95 per cent of its 3300 members in California, Oregon, Nevada, Utah, Arizona, New Mexico and part of Texas have authorized the negotiating committee to call a strike, if necessary.

Grand Rapids, Mich. — (U.P.) — Grace Kelly, America's No. 1 Irish bride-to-be, was a green bedroom suite from the nation's furniture capitol today by the friendly sons of St. Patrick.
"Grace is a fine Irish girl and the best is none too good for her," John S. Casey, president of the Grand Rapids Chapter of the Friendly Sons, said.
The friendly sons decided on a "wedding present for Grace" campaign as its main project for St. Patrick's day this year.
"We thought it was a suitable project because Miss Kelly's father, John, is active in the Philadelphia chapter where the group's international headquarters are located," Casey said.
