LIVE RICHLI EVERY DAY. A while ago I was made thoughtful by the story told me by a highly cultured widow, a patient of mine. She told me how when her elderly and able and well-to-do husband had a cancer of the bowel cut out, the surgeon had said he was sorry but some of the bad cells had grown into the liver and all that could be hoped for was perhaps another year of life.

The man did not fuss or fret or become fearful about this. He just said to his wife, "Let us make this coming year the happiest and richest and most beautiful that we have ever known."

They searched out gifted students, working their way, through nearby universities; they made friends of these young people and lent or gave them money with which greatly to ease their strain of living.

I think theirs was a beautiful idea. Many persons will doubtless say, "But they had wealth; my wife and I could not do anything like that." Perhaps not exactly, but you could do many things to live beautifully and happily for a memorable year.

Jordan Legionnaires Attack Israel Patrol

Jerusalem, Israel Sector—(U.P.) Troops of Jordan's Arab Legion and Jordanian frontier guards attacked an Israel patrol Sunday, the Israeli government has announced.

A communique said the attack came on the Beersheba-Hebron road paralleling the border and that there were no casualties. It said the Israelies returned the fire.

It was the first attack in that area since 1954 and marked the first time Arab legionnaires have been involved in skirmishing since Jordan fired Lt. Gen. Sir John Glubb Pasha as head of the Legion.

It coincided with reports young King Hussein was planning a visit to the leaders of other Arab states to show he is for Arab unity.

A dispatch from Amman quoted the young monarch's chief minister as saying Hussein was planning to visit the Arab capital in answer to new Arab pressure for Jordan to throw off all Western ties.

Ray C. Anderson, advertising and business manager of the Observer since 1941, will take over as Observer editor and publisher on April 1. Weybret will leave La Grande the end of this week.

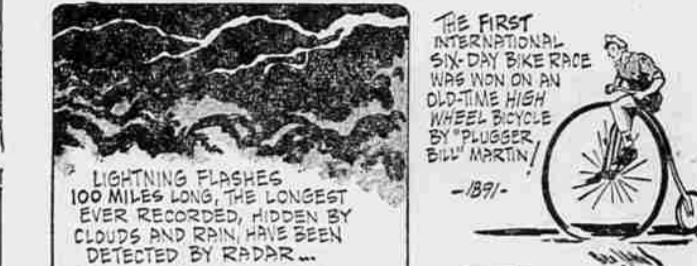

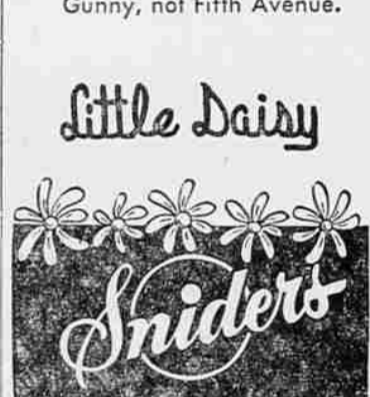

Village in Cyprus Fined in Reprisal

Nicosia, Cyprus (U.P.)—Governor Sir John Harding has fined the village of Lapithos \$19,600 in reprisal for an anti-British bombing attack Saturday by Cypriot extremists.

The collective fine, heaviest yet imposed on a Cyprus town, came as a British soldier died today from injuries suffered in another bombing Saturday in Nicosia.
