Donald Sorrell said today the liner Queen Mary "behaved very well" in a nightmare Atlantic crossing that injured 100 persons. The 81,000-ton Cunard liner did not suffer any damage in a 70-mile-an-hour gale which struck two days out of New York, he said. Six persons were hospitalized when the liner arrived here. Two others were taken off at Cherbourg France. Fifty of the injured were crewmembers. Passengers were flung from their beds as the 20-year-old ship rolled at a 48-degree angle.
