# Profound Undertaking Hidden Behind Religion, Health Group

United Press Science Editor New York—(U.P.)—Hidden behind a prosaic announcement of the formation of a National Academy of Religion and Mental Health is one of the most profound undertakings of our age—the first big scale effort to reconcile the conflicting conceptions of psychology as to the nature of human beings.

been launched to sponsor scientific research into relationships between religion and mental health, to promote instruction in psychology for students in the seminaries of all faiths, to aid medical and especially psychiatric students to seek "knowledge from theology and moral philosophy"—among a number of similar projects.

Although the founder of the modern science of psychology, Sigmund Freud, was outspokenly anti-religious, the science isn't. As Dr. Kenneth F. Appel, the academy's first president, put it, psychology "cannot help but recognize not only a moral sense in human beings but moral values in a patient's environment."

High Caliber Officers. The scope of the academy is obvious in the caliber of its officers. Dr. Appel is a former president of the American Psychiatric Association and professor of psychology at the University of Pennsylvania. A vice-president is the Rev. Otis R. Rice, long prominent in affairs of the National Council of Churches of Christ in the U.S.A. The advisory council includes two Catholic priests and educators, a rabbi, the president of a Baptist theological seminary, two professors of Protestant theology, three

professors of psychology, three professors of psychiatry, and two former presidents and the president elect of the American Psychiatric Association.

These leaders who have devoted so much time and energy to launching the academy, acknowledged there had been many difficulties, but as Dr. Appel put it, "many of the difficulties were of semantics"—of religionists and scientists talking about the same thing with different words.

Knowledge Related. After several years of private meetings and earnest striving, a group of highly respected leaders in both fields have explored the common concern of religion and science for the well-being of human beings. Religion and science have each conceded that the other has "knowledge concerning human behavior." They have agreed that mental health is indispensable to human well-being and that mental health can only be advanced when all kinds of knowledge of human behavior are related.
