# Adlai in California To Map Strategy for Presidential Primary

Los Angeles — (U.P.) — Adlai Stevenson arrives here today to map strategy for his "do or die" campaign in the California presidential primary.

Stevenson cancelled a Florida vacation to make a three-day California trip to consult with his campaign heads here amid reports of growing support for Sen. Estes Kefauver.

Paul Ziffren, California Democratic national committeeman and a Stevenson backer, said the June 5 California primary "is a do-or-die election" for the 1952 Democratic presidential candidate.

Stevenson has got to win here," Ziffren said. "But there is no question that he will win."

Kefauver departed from International airport here Tuesday night after a five-day speech and hand-shaking tour of southern California. He maintained the same breakneck pace here that supporters claim helped produce his upset victory over Stevenson in the Minnesota primary.

Ziffren said he and State Attorney General Edmund G. (Pat) Brown, state campaign manager for Stevenson, are neither "frantic nor panicky" about the California primary.

"Both Pat and I agree that the situation is well in hand," Ziffren said. "Kefauver is doing a fine job, but I'm certain he is running for the vice-presidency."

Stevenson will make what was described as a "major" local television address here tonight. Meetings with many of his campaign leaders also were scheduled tonight and Thursday before he goes to San Francisco. He plans to leave for Illinois on Friday from San Francisco.
