Casselman, Ont. — (U.P.) — Five children ranging in age from two months to five years were killed Wednesday night when fire razed their farm home in this community 35 miles southeast of Ottawa.

A sixth child and the mother were in a nearby barn when the fire broke out and were unhurt.

The victims were the children of Mr. and Mrs. Alcide Quenol. They were Helen, 5, Jean-Guy, 4, Claude, 2, and 2-months old twins Francois and Francoise.

Quenol, 24, works in a general store at St. Isidore. The house was gutted and the children were dead when he arrived home.

Ontario provincial police said they did not know how the fire started.

The 22-year-old mother told police she was in a barn with her sixth child, three-year-old Gerald, when the fire started. She smelled smoke and heard the crackle of flames too late to save the children in the frame house.

Stillwater, Okla. — (U.P.) — If your hens go on a sit-down strike, don't blame them—blame the weather says an Oklahoma A.&M. College poultry expert.

Alex Warren said prolonged dry weather in Oklahoma fills the air with static electricity. It makes hens nervous, especially the caged layers, and nervous hens don't lay eggs.

Warren said experiments have shown that if poultry raisers ground each row of cages with copper wire, the hens will overcome their nervousness and lay more eggs.
