Men Who Pose As Physicians

Some small hospitals in their great need for interns and assistant physicians are inclined to be careless as they employ men who call themselves physicians. I was just reading of a man who was employed by a hospital as a night physician. Later, they learned that his only qualification for the job of taking care of sick persons was that he had once run a pet shop! He told the hospital authorities that he had been well educated, first, at Columbia and later, in a medical school in Edinburgh, Scotland, but when the Deans of these schools were asked about him, they said he had never studied with them.

In another hospital in the same district a man who had been employed as an anesthetist turned out to be only a chiropractor. As I said, this is like discovering that a pilot on an airplane has never had any training in the air, or like learning that the captain of the ship one is on has never been to sea!

Many persons may wonder why there is such carelessness in employing physicians, but there is nothing puzzling about it. Although we human beings are very fussy about the training of an air pilot or a ship's captain, into whose hands we are to place our lives, more than half of us resent it when the government attempts to examine a man who says he is a physician. Curiously, if he really is a physician, all of us believe in being tough with him, and giving him a very good examination, but if he is not a physician, we agree with him that to exam-

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Around Hollywood

Hollywood — (U.P.) — One of the losing nominees in the Oscar derby was an unusual, exciting motion picture with bronze statues and not one human being in the cast.

The film was "The Battle of Gettysburg." It lost in the documentary category to "The Face of Lincoln." But "Gettysburg" was one of the year's most interesting films.

It has no script, dialogue or sets—just history. MGM chief Dore Schary conceived the idea of saving you a trip to see the historic Gettysburg battlefield in Pennsylvania. He sent Director Herman Hoffman, a talented

maker of documentaries, to the spot.

Battle Included
Hoffman recreated the battle—with the statues on the battlefield of the generals and soldiers taking their "parts." Sound effects of marching feet and booming guns were added. Hoffman achieved "motion" by quickly cutting from one statue to the other, from one gun to the next. The director and his camera-men spent eight days on the battlefield.

The head of the Gettysburg Park knows the battle inside and sideways," Hoffman said. "Every night we'd fight the battle with him, and the next day we'd go out and shoot what he told us."

The film took months to edit. Schary himself wrote a narration. And the entire costly project, says Hoffman, was "a labor of love."

Technique Revived
His technique of using quick cutting and a moving camera to tell the story, instead of dialogue, has been the talk of Hollywood. Actually it's an old technique originated in the early silent movie days—but forgotten by most present-day directors and wide scenes. The late Robert Flaherty used it several years ago in "The Titan."
