

Grace Kelly Boards Ocean Liner To Sail for Monaco and Wedding

New York — (U.P.) — Movie star Grace Kelly boarded the liner Constitution today to sail to her royal wedding amid a clamor that almost resembled a mob scene.

She said she was "A little numb . . . very excited . . . and very happy" as she left to marry the Prince of Monaco and live in a palace.

Police literally pushed photographers up the ship's gangway to clear a path for the bride-to-be. And many sightseers crashed what was arranged as a quiet press conference.

Taking Present

Miss Kelly appeared cool, calm and collected as she sat at a corner table of the ship's pool cafe.

Miss Kelly said she hadn't talked to her fiancé, Prince Rainier II, since he left Hollywood a month ago to go home and prepare for their wedding.

But she's taking him a present, she said. She wouldn't say what, because "I want it to be a surprise."

Her parents, sister and the nieces who will be among her wedding party had boarded the ship shortly before she arrived.

The 26-year-old Philadelphia girl who topped her sudden rise to movie stardom by capturing the 32-year-old Prince in a

whirlwind Christmas courtship, will be married in a civil ceremony April 18 and a church ceremony April 19 in the Riviera principality.

More than 60 of the wedding guests as well as Mr. and Mrs. John B. Kelly Sr., the bride-to-be's parents, four bridesmaids and the specially-packed wedding dress also are traveling on the ship with Miss Kelly.

Two Extend Winnings On '\$64,000 Question'

New York — (U.P.) — A jockey spurred his winnings to \$16,000 in a "great art and artists" category and a 76-year-old woman won \$8000 on horse racing last night on "The \$64,000 Question" television quiz show.

Mrs. Ida Mae Shurburne, Nicholasville, Ky., correctly named the eight horses who have won racing's triple crown.

The reunion with Prince Rainier, who last saw his future princess in Hollywood a month ago, will be a dramatic shipboard meeting in the harbor of Monaco April 12. The Constitution will anchor in the harbor after the regular passengers debark at Cannes, France, so the prince can pull alongside in the honeymoon yacht to take Miss Kelly and her family aboard.

The prince is one of the most titled of Europe's monarchs, and Miss Kelly inherits all of the

titles. He has two titles of prince, eight of count, four of duke and five of baron.

Miss Kelly regards her voyage to join the prince as "my only vacation" before the wedding. She has spent the past two weeks hastily assembling her trousseau, which a friend described as "practical by royal standards." It will be aboard the ship in two trunks and numerous suitcases. Her wedding dress was put aboard in a special aluminum crate her brother, John Jr.,

described as "like a coffin."
