Nausea

Many want to know what causes nausea. I think, often, it is associated with waves coming back up the digestive tract. That is why it is so marked a symptom before a person vomits. At times it is probably produced in the brain or in the balancing mechanism in the ears. My experience with the first Cinerama, when I seemed to be going down a big amusement park roller coaster, showed me that impressions taken in by the eyes can cause nausea. I remember a woman who became nauseated when she found an inch-worm in her salad, and another who became terribly nauseated, and vomited when her beau proposed to her in a restaurant. I remember a Mohammedan student in this country who became terribly nauseated when pranksters in his boarding-house told him that unknowingly he had just eaten pork.

I remember a girl who suffered from much nausea when her beau eloped with another woman. Other women got nausea when they found that the man they had married was repellent to them.

Nausea When Tired
I sometimes get nausea when very tired, and I know business men who, after a hard day in the office, will get nausea at night.

"Disease in the digestive tract" it is usually low in the bowel. In older persons I have seen it come as the first symptom of an intestinal obstruction due perhaps, to cancer. One very rarely sees nausea with diseases in the upper part of the digestive tract, such as the gullet, stomach, duodenum, or gallbladder. It is not a common symptom with ulcers of the stomach or duodenum. To get relief a person can now try one of the anti-seasick drugs.

Astronomers Study Twinkle, Twinkle

Philadelphia — (U.P.) — The twinkle, twinkle of little stars is getting a close look from University of Pennsylvania astronomers. It may indicate the speed and direction of certain high-altitude winds.

Under a research contract with the Air Force geophysics research directorate, Drs. William M. Protheroe and William Blitstein, are clocking the rapid variations in light that make the stars appear to twinkle.

The observations of the two scientists will be compared with weathermen's reports of the velocity, direction, and altitude of winds over the same area at the same time. They hope to reduce the effect of the winds on scintillation, or twinkle, to a formula which will enable meteorologists to gauge upper-air wind speed by "reading" the stars.

The study also may reveal clues to the meanderings of the jet stream, a wind current of super-hurricane force that radically influences high-altitude aviation.
