Hollywood, Fla. — (U.P.) — A young Ohio couple was arrested here yesterday for stealing \$45 from a church poor box.

Police said they picked up Frank and Audrey Sumpter of St. Bernard, O., as they left the darkened church of the Little Flower early yesterday morning. Sgt. Gerry Oldziej said he noticed Sumpter, 30, hurrying away from the church carrying something in his jacket. A search revealed a flashlight, a tire iron, a screwdriver and pockets full of change, Oldziej said.

Mrs. Sumpter accidentally kicked out an unopened poor box as she stepped from the car, he said.

Authorities said a side door to the church had been forced open and the box wrenched from the wall.

Fong Pleased With Judge's Acquittal

Portland — (U.P.) — This was the happiest Friday the 13th in the life of Wey Him Fong.

He walked out of jail yesterday after being suddenly acquitted of a murder charge in connection with the death in 1954 of 16-year-old Diane Hank.

Fong's retrial came to an abrupt end when Circuit Judge Frank J. Lonergan ordered a directed verdict of acquittal on grounds of insufficient evidence.

Fong was released after bail was posted on two lesser charges, after hours and contributing to the delinquency of a minor.

Fong's wife, Sherry, was convicted earlier of second degree murder but has appealed to the State Supreme Court.
