

Ike Welcomes Soviet Help in Middle East

Washington — (U.P.) — The White House said today that President Eisenhower welcome the Russia's offer to help solve the Mid-East crisis, if it "demonstrates a real desire" by Moscow to backing U.N. peace efforts.

Council Authorizes Plans for Paving Work, Sewer Projects

The Medford city council last night adopted ordinances authorizing plans and specifications for three paving projects, and received petitions for two other projects.

Plans and specifications were authorized for paving on East Second st. between North Front st. and North Central Ave., and on South Modoc ave. between East Main st. and Woodlawn dr., and on Niantic st. between Edwards st. and Maple st. The petition for Niantic st. paving was signed by 52.14 per cent of the property owners, according to city officials.

Request Paving
Petitions were received requesting paving on Kenwood ave. between Humphry st. and West Second st. and on Fairmont st. between Summit ave. and the east end of the present dedicated street.

Mayor Earl Miller reported that 59.24 per cent of the property owners had signed the Ken-

wood ave. petition and that 54.9 per cent had signed the Fairmont st. petition.

Ordinances also were passed adopting plans and specifications for construction of a sanitary sewer in blocks four and five in the Highcroft addition, and hearing on the project was set for May 15.

An ordinance was adopted authorizing a sanitary sewer project in an area bounded by Capital ave. on the north, Valley View dr. on the east, the north boundary line of Valley View subdivision on the south and Sunrise ave. on the west now served with sewer. The council also authorized the project. No one appeared to object at a public hearing last night.

Assessment Ordinance
An ordinance levying 84 assessments for water main installations in the recently annexed Laurelhurst addition also was adopted. The cost per linear foot of frontage to be assessed is \$2.14 according to City Manager Robert Duff.

The council called a public hearing May 15 on annexation of two lots on Murray st. at Columbus ave., and other property in the area. The other property includes Columbus ave., to the north line of the alley, north of block eight, West Side Heights addition two; Murray st. from Columbus ave. to the west boundary of West Side Heights addition two; and the alley north of block eight from Columbus ave. to the west boundary of West Side Heights addition two.

Duff pointed out that the property, except the two lots, is presently city-owned, but outside the city limits. The streets and alley cannot be dedicated to public use unless annexed first, he pointed out. The council authorized Mayor Miller to represent the city in annexation proceedings since the city owns property involved.

Finance Committee
The council adopted a recommendation of the finance committee to levy assessments on a per square foot basis in block four of Highcroft addition, and on a per lot basis in block five. Both are for sanitary sewer improvements. The committee pointed out that the per square foot basis appeared to be more equitable because only three lots were involved, and that in block five, the per lot basis more equitable because the lots are almost the same size.

A request from the Jackson

County Disaster Car group that a site beside the East Side Fire station be made available for housing the car was denied by the council. The planning commission recommended that the request be granted.

Councilmen pointed out that should the Disaster Car be housed at the site, the property would have to be rezoned, and that residents may believe the Disaster Car is operated by the fire department. Members of the council pointed out that the Car is not connected with the fire department.

To Prepare Ordinance
The council authorized City Attorney Frank Farrell to prepare an ordinance calling for a hearing on vacation of a north-south alley in the Edwards place addition. Vacation of the alley was recommended by the planning commission.

Action on a planning commission recommendation that an agriculture ordinance be adopted was deferred until a later meeting, as was action on a recommendation of vacating 55 feet of Marshall ave. through Garfield subdivision.

A no parking zone on the west side of Riverside ave. 75 feet south of Jackson st. was approved, and three one-hour parking meters were replaced in front of the old Jackson County Chamber of Commerce office on South Riverside ave. No parking between 4:30 and 6 p.m. was approved for the three places to facilitate right turn traffic movements.

The council authorized a crosswalk across Sixth st. in front of the YMCA, where a blinker light will be installed, and granted two-hour parking in six places on South Riverside ave.—two each in front of Tabu restaurant, in front of Lusk Piano house and in front of Barco Chemical Supply company. Duff pointed out that the spaces are usually occupied with all-day parkers.

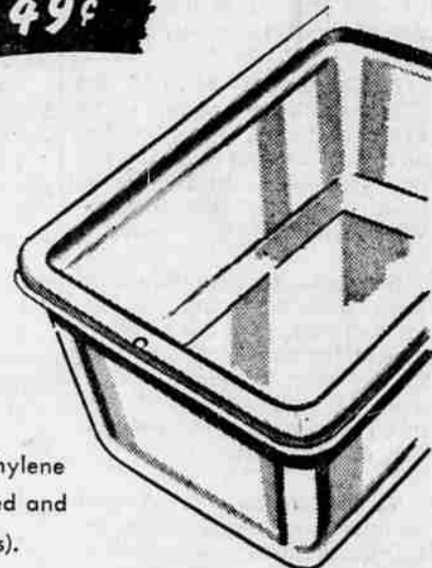

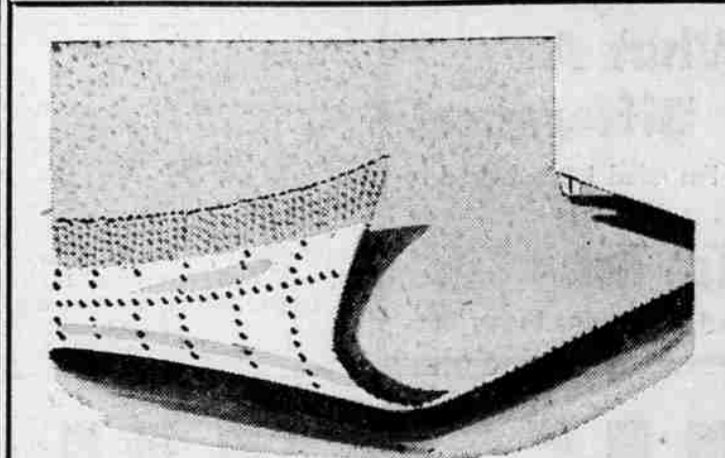
