

Blabber Barber Probably Has Never Been To Barber College, School Head Asserts

Chicago—(U.P.)—If the man who cuts your hair is a "blabber barber," the chances are he hasn't been to college.

The blabber barbers are the ones who think they know it all and want you to know they do, says Jack Eisenga, general manager of the Moler Barber College in Chicago.

Instructors at the college indulge in a little eavesdropping to detect and warn gabby beginners who might develop into full-fledged blabbers.

"Listening to a student's conversation with a customer is part of the teacher's job," Eisenga said.

Silent Heads

Students also are cautioned against using a gruff voice or talking to customers who just don't want to talk while getting a haircut.

Years ago, when a haircut cost a quarter, a barber only had to know how to clip hair and give a shave, Eisenga says. Today the price is up and so is the barber's background of book-learning and experience.

"Modern barbers can sharpen a razor or talk about anatomy if they've been to a barber college," Eisenga said.

Illinois law requires a student to spend at least 1,872 hours in school before he can be appren-

ted. Other states have similar requirements but Illinois and West Virginia have the highest, Eisenga said.

Anatomy, skin disease, hygiene and bacteriology are some of the subjects covered during the nine months. A student barber studies the human body, Eisenga says, because he works on or near your skin.

"A barber shouldn't slap a hot towel on someone's face unless he knows where the nerve endings are," he said.

Eisenga says the new "barber science" has been raising the caliber of barbers since 1930, but the deft touch of skillful conversation still counts.

"In the long run a successful barber is 25 per cent craftsman and 75 per cent personality," Eisenga says.

KF Pilot Tumbles 5 Miles Through Air

Dublin, N. H.—(U.P.)—An Air Force plane blew up 40,000 feet above Mount Monadnock and the Oregon pilot fell an estimated five miles through the air before his parachute automatically opened.

The pilot, Lt. John P. Linman Jr. of Klamath Falls, Ore., was on a routine flight yesterday from the Air Force base at Bedford, Mass.

At 40,000 feet over Mount Monadnock, he reported, the tail pipe of his plane blew up and he hit the ejection button that automatically catapulted him into space.

Air Force officials at Bedford said Linman fell an estimated 30,000 feet before his parachute was opened by an automatic device activated by air pressure.

Linman, who landed in a tree and was rescued by a telephone line crew, was treated by Dr. Robert D. Sterling, who said the flier was "shaken up but unharmed."

New Nash Agency Plans Formal Opening

About \$700,000 in Bond Investments Going Unclaimed

Washington, April — (CQ)—The Treasury is holding about \$700,000 of the taxpayer's money because the taxpayers haven't bothered to get it back.

The funds represent partial payments on U.S. Savings Bonds by participants in the payroll savings plans sponsored by many business firms for their employees. Under the plan, a flat amount is deducted from each paycheck; when enough has been accumulated, a bond is issued.

Some workers quit the job or stop saving before enough has accumulated for a bond. These partial payments, if not claimed by the employee, have been taken over by the Treasury as a convenience to the business firms which didn't want to keep them on the books.

Since 1944, the Treasury has received \$746,000 this way, representing 148,000 individual accounts. Almost one-third of the accounts have less than \$1 in them. The average is about \$5 and none is over \$17.75—the purchase price of a \$25 savings bond.

Transfer Approved
The unclaimed funds came to light in March, when the Senate approved a bill to transfer \$500,000 of this money to another fund in the Treasury. The bill is now before the House Government Operations Committee.

Treasury sources say there's no danger the transfer of funds will block anybody's attempt to reclaim his share of the \$700,000 kitty. In fact, they wish more claims would be made, so they could get them off their books.

In the past five years, however, the Treasury has paid out less than \$5,000.

Persons who think they might have some money coming can write the Bureau of Accounts, Treasury Department, Washington, D. C., giving their name, the name of the firm through which the partial payments were made and the approximate date.

With \$700,000 in prize money and 148,000 guaranteed winners, the odds are better than in most contests.

Hyenas Carry Away Children in India

New Delhi, India—(U.P.)—Roving hyenas have carried away about two dozen children in the Allahabad Hinterland, it was reported here today.

The reports said panic has gripped the area in northeast India and parents have been urged not to permit children to sleep in the open.

Touring Russians Greet Scandinavian Premiers

London — (U.P.)—Soviet leaders Nikolai Bulganin and Nikita Khrushchev radioed greetings to the premiers of Sweden and Norway as they passed those countries by ship en route to Britain Tuesday.
