The Medical Roundup

Can One Overcome Heredity?

Whenever I happen to say that nervous troubles may be inherited, a number of good people write to scold me roundly for having discouraged everyone. They think I said that no one can escape or overcome the bad effects of heredity, or that hereditary troubles are incurable. Actually, I never wrote any such stupid thing and will never write any such thing. For instance: People write angrily because I said stuttering sometimes runs through a family. I could have said that in the family of one of my patients, stuttering has afflicted six close relatives. How then can there be any question that sometimes a tendency to the impediment is inherited. Note that I said a tendency can sometimes be inherited. People should

know, also, that in some families in which one or two members stutter others have tics (convulsive movements of their face or shoulders) and others have poor control of several of their muscles. The good people who wrote me angrily were upset because they read into what I said something that was not there. They got the idea so universally held today that simply because a mental or psychic trait is inherited, nothing can be done about it. As I wrote some of my correspondents, I stuttered a bit when I was a child, but my mother soon trained me out of it, and ever since I have had no difficulty in speaking. I inherited from one of my grandmothers a strong temper but when I was about 20 I decided I didn't want it any more, and so I quickly trained myself to be so peaceful that today I rarely explode, and then only under great provocation.

Depression Inherited

The other day I had in the office a lovely old general practitioner of 75, who told me that his mother had been insane. He had inherited her tendency to depression and it had hounded him all his days. But, as he said, "I have hung onto my sanity like grim death, and as you see, today I am still sane."

When people accuse me of having said that a hereditary disease is not curable I remind them that diabetes and pernicious anemia are usually hereditary in their origin and yet no one any longer needs to die of them. Hence I beg you readers, when I mention heredity as the cause of some nervous disease, do not jump to the conclusion that I am saying that is incurable and hopeless, and that nothing can be done for it. Dr. Alvarez regrets he hasn't the time in which to read or answer requests for information.

Corvallis Watchman Killed in Mill Fall

Corvallis — (U.P.) — A 31-year-old father of three children was killed Monday night when he apparently fell about eight feet while working as a night watchman at the Three G Lumber Company at Harlan, Ore., about 30 miles west of here.

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Bulgaria Unanimously Elects New Premier

Belgrade — (U.P.) — Anton Yugov, 52, was unanimously elected Premier of Bulgaria yesterday to succeed Vulko Chervenkov who resigned under fire as a Stalinist, the official Yugoslav News Agency reported from Sofia.

Yugov was first deputy premier under the Chervenkov regime. His election by the Bulgarian Parliament followed yesterday's announcement that Chervenkov had resigned following bitter criticism of him for adhering to Stalin's now-discredited "cult of the individual."

Yugov, like his predecessor, is a veteran Communist. Yugov, born in a Macedonian village, participated in Communist demonstrations at the age of 12. He formally joined the Communist youth movement at the age of 20, and was arrested a number of times during his early career. He studied in Moscow in 1935, returned to his homeland in 1936 and organized a series of strikes.
