

Sutherland Youngster Drowns in Post Hole

Sutherland—(UP)—Laura Jean Holloper, 2, drowned yesterday when she slipped and fell in a water-filled post hole 2½ feet deep here.

The little girl, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Edwin Holloper of Sutherland, had been missing about half an hour when she was found. Five doctors and the Oakland fire department respirator squad worked for some time in a futile effort to save the child.

The post hole, which had been dug for a fence, had filled with water because of heavy ground saturation. The Douglas county coroner's office said the little girl apparently slipped and fell head first into the hole.

Troops To Resupply Stations on DEW Line

San Francisco—(UP)—A task force of more than 3000 specially trained Army troops will leave from East and West coasts in July to resupply isolated Arctic stations of the "distant Early Warning Line," radar network.

Plans for the mission were disclosed yesterday by the Pacific Transportation Terminal Command in San Francisco and by Army Secretary Wilbur M. Brucker.

The Eastern task force will leave Fort Eustis, Va., late in July, while the Western task force will leave at the same time from Seattle Army Terminal. Both forces will meet in the Arctic in August. They will return by early October.

LEGAL NOTICES

RESOLUTION NO. 831
A RESOLUTION proposing to permit adjacent property to use a water main as a lateral water main; to levy an assessment on the property fronting on the streets wherein said water main is laid; setting a time and place for protests thereto and providing for notice thereof.

WHEREAS the City of Medford has heretofore caused a water main in the City of Medford to be laid on Biddle Road from Jackson Street to a point 651 feet North, and the Council being of the opinion that said water main may be used by the property fronting on that portion of said main on Biddle Road from Jackson Street to a point 651 feet North, in the City of Medford, Oregon, and

WHEREAS said water main has not, as yet, been paid for and it appearing to the Council that the use of said water main as a lateral water main by said property last above mentioned will not materially interfere with the use thereof for the purpose for which it was originally laid, and the Council proposing to permit the owners of adjacent property to use the same for lateral purposes as aforesaid.

Section 1. That it is the opinion of the Council that that part of the aforementioned water main laid in the City of Medford described as follows, to-wit:

As laid on Biddle Road from Jackson Street to a point 651 feet North in the City of Medford, Oregon. May be used by the property fronting thereon as a lateral water main without materially interfering with the use thereof for the purpose of a water main, the purpose for which it was originally laid, and the Council proposes to permit the owners of adjacent property to use the same for lateral purposes as aforesaid.

Section 2. It is the intention of the Council to assess the property fronting on the streets wherein said water main is laid as heretofore last described its proportionate share of so much of the cost thereof as equals the benefit which will result from said property from the use of said water main as a lateral water main of such size as would be required to supply the property fronting on said streets in case said water main was not so used and the Council has and does hereby determine that the sum of \$2.25 per front foot is the amount of such special benefit and the proportionate cost of such a lateral water main to such property as aforesaid and intends to assess said amount against such adjacent property on account thereof.

Section 3. The Council will meet at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P. M. at the Council Chamber in the City Hall on the 1st day of May, 1956, at which time and place all protests or objections, as heretofore provided for, will be heard.

Section 4. The Recorder is hereby directed to serve notice hereof upon the property owners aforesaid by publishing this resolution 3 times in a newspaper published and of general circulation in said City and by posting the same in 5 public places in said City; said publication and said posting to be not less than 10 days before the date of said meeting.
