## The Medical Roundup

### A Small Goiter

Many persons want to know if they should have a small goiter removed. If they have a toxic goiter that makes them feel warm, terribly nervous, shaky, and unable to sleep, and if they have a fast pulse, much perspiration, loss of weight, and perhaps bulging eyes, they should go quickly to a good physician. Today, there are drug treatments that can help, but some experts prefer that a surgeon remove most of the toxin-producing gland.

When a goiter is not toxic, or when it is just a nodule sticking out from the thyroid gland, there may not be any immediate rush about removing it. However, since it was recently shown at the Mayo Clinic that 1 in 20 of such goiters contains cancerous tissue, many surgeons believe that the safest thing is to remove the enlarged part of the gland. Many persons will ask, "But why not just watch it and have the operation when the thing begins to grow?" The answer is that often by the time the thing starts growing, cancer has already spread so far that it cannot all be removed.

Many persons want to know what to do when the tendous part of the palm of the hand—

usually on the outer side, corresponding to the ring finger—forms a ridge which then contracts and pulls the last two fingers down. This is called a Dupuytren's contraction. Persons with this can get relief by going to a surgeon who will dissect out the little band of contracted tissue. It is well to have this done before the fingers are drawn way down. It is not an operation that needs to be feared.

## Seek Immediate Stop On Pelton Dam Work

Portland - (U.P.) - An immediate stop work order on Pelton dam was demanded Saturday by the Oregon Fish and Game commissions.

H. T. Hoy, director of fisheries, and P. W. Schneider, director of the State Game Commission, asked the Federal Power commission to stop work started on the Deschutes river by Portland General Electric company.

Hoy and Schneider said final plans for fishery facilities have not yet been approved by the FPC and that PGE has been presenting the plans piecemeal. They said they were alarmed because the Portland utility has been pushing its construction on a tight time schedule.

## 'Mountain' of Salt Holds Butane Supply

Sour Lake, Tex. - (U.P.) - A five-mile high "mountain" of salt lying underground nearby has been converted into a "bank" for reserve butane supplies by an oil and fuel company.

The mountain—"dome" in geology language—is not uncommon along Texas' Gulf coast, but this one is unique in that it has become a proving ground for some ideas of scientists of the Texas Company, which is using part of the mountain as an underground storage tank.

Texaco conceived the idea of the "bank" when the company needed facilities to store a large quantity of butane, a petroleum derivative used in the manufacture of certain types of gasoline.

Four wells were drilled into the dome and water was introduced under pressure to dissolve the salt and bring it to the surface in the form of brine. With this process, caverns were hollowed out large enough to hold a total of 460,000 barrels of fluid.

Butane was pumped into the reservoir wells through a pipeline from Port Arthur and returned to the refinery through the same line. The company said the entire operation was "quite satisfactory."

## Claims Oregon Has No Superior Law School

San Francisco - (U.P.) - An expert on legal education said Saturday America has too many inferior law schools and singled out Oregon as a state without a single superior law school.

The criticism was leveled by Attorney John G. Hervey of Oklahoma City, legal education advisor to the American Bar association and former law dean at Tulane university and the University of Oklahoma.

In an address before the fifth annual conference of western law schools, Hervey cited California as an example of a superior law school state.

"There are 17 law schools in California but only 10 in New York; 11 in Ohio contrasted with seven in Illinois; and seven in Georgia compared with four in Florida. There is no superior law school in Oregon," he said.
