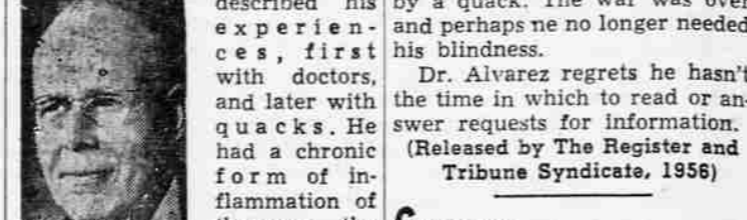

The Medical Roundup

When a Physician Can't Diagnose or Cure (Continued from Tuesday) I have a book in my library written by a brilliant biologist, who after slowly going blind, described his experiences, first with doctors, and later with quacks. He had a chronic form of inflammation of the eye, the nature of which is still unknown. Because no ophthalmologist's knows the cause of the inflammation, he has no medicine for it, and there is mighty little that he can even try to do in the way of treatment. The columnist, being an educated man, went first to a dozen of the leading eye specialists in the United States. They all told him the same thing. Then, as he said, he knew that he should not have gone to quacks, but "When you're going blind you just can't sit down and do nothing; you've got to do something; and it feels good when a man guarantees you a cure, even though he insists on getting \$500 in advance. A few weeks later, when you discover that his treatment is not doing anything, you move on to another quack."



Some of you readers doubtless will write me, as many have done of late, that once you had a supposedly incurable disease and you finally found a quack who "cured you." I have seen enough such cases to know that often the diagnosis was wrong, while in other cases the patient was one of those lucky ones in whom an often incurable disease—even cancer—will let up and quiet down. I have known person, even with scattered cancer, who, without taking anything, got well. They and the cancer cells learned to live amicably together.

Not so infrequently we doctors make mistakes and fail to recognize that a patient's whole trouble—even blindness—is due purely to hysteria and fear. Any day such a person can be cured by a quack or a faith-healer. During World War I, I went to hear a blind man lecture. As he walked onto the platform, I said to the person with me, "Every bit of medical intuition I have and knowledge of how a blind man looks and walks tells me that that fellow is not blind." Hence I was not surprised when two months later I read that the man had suddenly been "cured" by a quack. The war was over and perhaps he no longer needed his blindness.

Oregon Veneer Low Bidder on Timber

Oregon Veneer company, Medford, was successful bidder on 2,600,000 board feet of forest service timber in the Willow Prairie area of the Butte Falls ranger district at an oral auction Monday afternoon.

Oregon Veneer's bid of \$101,200 was the 94th oral bid submitted for the timber. Kogap Lumber company was second highest bidder.

The sale is a combination salvage and sanitation cutting to remove mistletoe and beetle-infested trees, some large "wolf type" trees, and trees of poor thrift as well as dead, down and dying trees on the 300-acre sale area.

Included in the sale were 2,100,000 board feet of Douglas fir, 200,000 board feet of pine, and 300,000 board feet of white pine, all of which will be selectively logged.

Two sales will be held Friday, April 27, at the forest service office. Both are salvage sales in the Union Creek range district.

The first sale is for 100,000 board feet of timber along Crater

The second sale is for 1,300,000 board feet of salvage timber in the Mill creek fire burn, and will be oral auction starting at 2 p.m. Friday.
