A New Booklet on Diabetes

Dr. Garfield G. Duncan has just published a good little book, full of information needed by diabetic patients. On page 85 there is an interesting diagram showing how diabetes is inherited. If a diabetic marries a non-diabetic who has no diabetes in the family, and the couple have four children, all can be carriers. If a diabetic marries an apparently normal carrier of diabetes, two of the children can be diabetic and two can be carriers. If two carriers marry, two of four children can be carriers, one can be a diabetic and one can go free. His (or her) children need not fear diabetes (unless it comes in from the spouse).
